established and in use, one Hundred and one rods distant from  
and South of the Southwest corner of the South east Quarter  
of Section Twenty township One South of Range thirty Nine  
39 East of Willamette Meridian in Union County Oregon, running  
thence in a Northerly direction along the railroad right of  
way to the dividing line between the lands of Jesse Imbler  
and Samuel Morris being the dividing line between the North  
Half of North East Quarter of Section twenty Nine Township



# REPORT OF VIEWERS.

TO THE HONORABLE COUNTY COURT FOR UNION COUNTY, OREGON:

The undersigned viewers heretofore on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of July, 1893, appointed to view and lay out and alter the proposed county road, of which the survey hereto attached is a true and correct description, as petitioned for by Wm Hull, et al, beg leave to report that on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of July, 1893, in pursuance with said appointment and order, after being duly sworn to faithfully and impartially discharge the duties of said appointment, we proceeded to view out said proposed road for the whole distance thereof, and that in our opinion said proposed road should not be laid out or established as a public highway of Union County, Oregon; that the same is not practicable and would not add to the convenience of the householders residing in the vicinity thereof. We therefore recommend that said proposed road be not laid out or declared a public highway of said county.

We the undersigned viewers heretofore on the 5 day of July 1893 appointed to view out and assess the damages claimed by Jas Patterson in the matter of the proposed county road petitioned for by J T Wiskens et al beg leave to report that on the 28 day of July 1893 we after being duly sworn to discharge our duty faithfully and impartially, proceeded to view said proposed road the whole distance through the premises of Jas Patterson, claimant, and to assess and determine how much less valuable said premises of said claimant would be rendered by the opening of said road, and we find that the premises of said claimant Jas Patterson would be rendered \$160 less valuable by the laying out and establishment of said proposed road as a public highway of said County and recommend that \$160 be paid to said claimant before laying out and establishing said road as a public highway.
