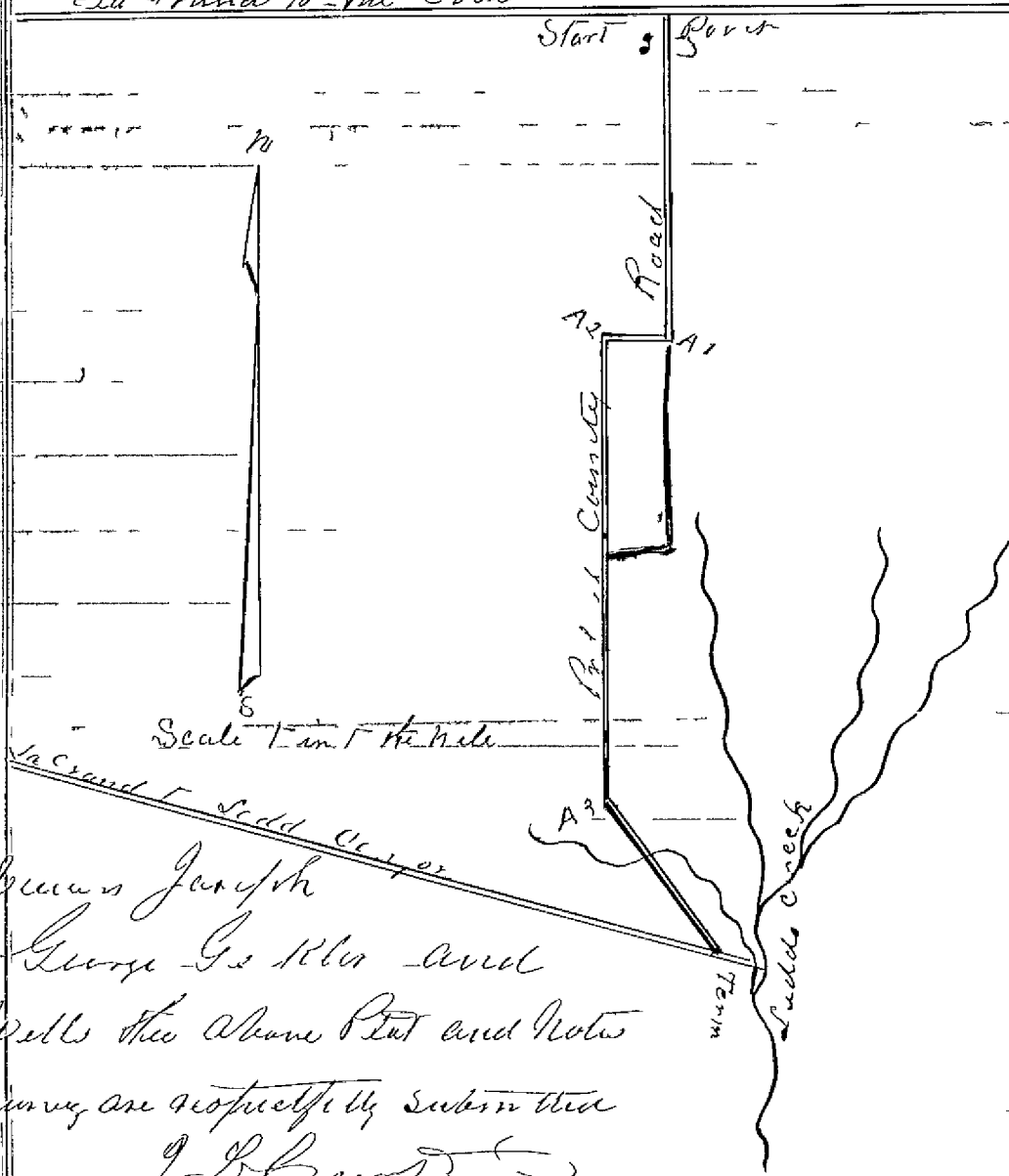

1872 asking for the location of a County
Road commencing at the N. E. corner
of Sec 14 in T 8 S R 2 E, at a point on
the Road leading from Se Grande to the Town
of Union, thence South 2 and three fourth
miles thence West one fourth mile thence
South one and one fourth miles thence in
a direct line to intersect the mouth of
what is known as Sadd Canyon
all of which points are in Union County
State of Oregon

Now therefore we S. Russell
and S. Alberson are held and firmly
bound to the County of Union
State of Oregon in the penal sum of
2 hundred dollars The conditions of the
above obligations are such that if
the prayer of the petitioners in said
petition be not granted and allowed
then this obligation to be in full
force and effect otherwise to be null

Proposed County Road

Now at this time was presented a petition of more than twelve resident householders, residing in the vicinity and along the route of a proposed County Road in Union County praying for the location and establishment of a County Road as follows viz: Commencing at the N^W Corner of Section 14 in Township Three South of Range 38 East, At a point on the Road leading from Selkand to the Town of Union, thence South two and three fourth Miles, thence West one fourth mile, thence South One and one fourth mile, thence on a direct line to intersect the mouth of what is known as the Ladd Canyon all in Union County State of Oregon. Which petition was duly accompanied with a Bond which Bond was approved by the Court, also with proof of the posting of Notices in accordance with law. It is therefore Ordered that George Gubler Joseph Yount and John Wells be and they are hereby appointed Viewers to mark and lay out said proposed County Road And J L Curtis is hereby appointed Surveyor who are to meet at the House of J A Childes on the 25th day of March 1872 and report their proceedings at the May term of this Court.

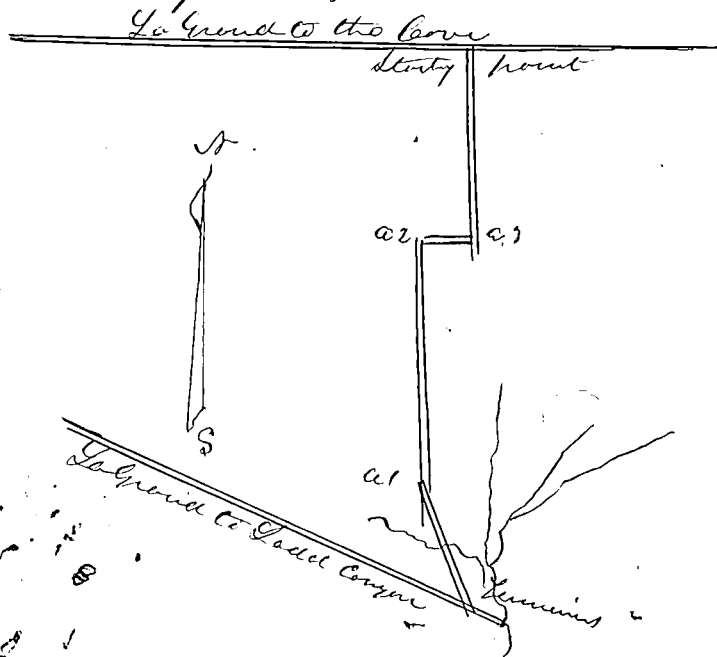

Now at this time
Come on for Consideration the Report of the
Viewers heretofore Appointed to View Mark
and Locate a County Road Commencing at
the NE Corner of Sec 14 T3 South Range 38 East
and Terminating Near the Mouth of the Ladd
Canyon, which Report sets forth that the
Viewers met at the place appointed on the
25th day of March 1872 and after being duly
Sworn proceeded to view out and locate said
Road with J L Curtis as Surveyor and that
the same the line practicable for a Public Highway
and of general benefit to the Citizens residing
in the Vicinity of the proposed Road of
which the following are the field notes and
plot of the same made by J L Curtis Surveyor
Commencing at the NE Corner of Sec 14 T3 S
Range 38 E Well Mer, and running thence South
2 3/4 Miles to Angle 1 Thence West 20 Chains to
Angle 2 and set Mile Post, Thence South 5 1/2
Mile and 37 Chains to Angle 3 Thence S by 33° E
62 Chains to the terminus of the Road at a post
Set on the Margin of the road leading from La Grange
to Mouth of Ladd Canyon whole distance five
Miles and 9 Chains,

of County Physicians for the
poor & Paupers of Co. 3

Now at this time the proposition of J H Kennedy coming on to be heard for medical attendance on the County poor It is Ordered that said J H Kennedy be allowed as follows to wit for One patient per day \$5⁰⁰ two patients per day 8⁰⁰ three patients or more at \$3⁰⁰ each, per day.

By the week for one patient \$15⁰⁰ for two patients \$25⁰⁰ three patients or more at the rate of \$10⁰⁰ per each patient, By the Month for one patient \$50⁰⁰ two patients \$80⁰⁰ three patients or more at the rate of \$30⁰⁰ per patient, and fifty cents mileage added, which proposition is hereby accepted the Court reserving the right to pay by the week whenever the number of days the amount shall exceed the the amount stated per week and also to pay by the Month when the amount per week shall exceed the amount per month.
