We, the undersigned citizens and householders of Union County, Oregon, and petitioners for the above entitled road, would most respectfully represent that the claim for damages filed herein by S.D.Ficklin for Fifty (\$50.00) Dellars, on which the Viewers appointed to view said road, allowed Forty (\$40.00) Dellars, is most unreasonable and unjust, and said amount so allowed is unreasonable and unjust. In this:

First:- That said land owned by \$.D.Fickdin is not worth to exceed eight dollars per acre, and there would be but little over one half acre appropriated for the proposed road.

Second:- That claimant has only a small garden patch fenced in, the east line of which would reach just about the west side of the proposed road and the claimant would not have to remove or rebuild any fence, whatever.

Third:- Claimant would not logse, by reason of said road any valuable or other water-rights whatever, as there is no spring nor stream along said proposed road.


