REPORT OF VIEWERS.

TO THE HONORABLE COUNTY COURT FOR UNION COUNTY, OREGON:

The undersigned viewers heretofore on the 28 day of Jan, 1895, appointed to view and lay out and alter the proposed county road, of which the survey hereto attached is a true and correct description, as petitioned for by Thos. Melkenson, et al, beg leave to report that on the 28 day of Jan, 1895, in pursuance with said appointment and order, after being duly sworn to faithfully and impartially discharge the duties of said appointment, we proceeded to view out said proposed road for the whole distance thereof, and that in our opinion said proposed road should not be laid out and established as a public highway of Union County, Oregon; that the same is not practicable and would not add to the convenience of the householders residing in the vicinity thereof. We therefore recommend that said proposed road be not laid out and ~~declared a main highway of said county.~~

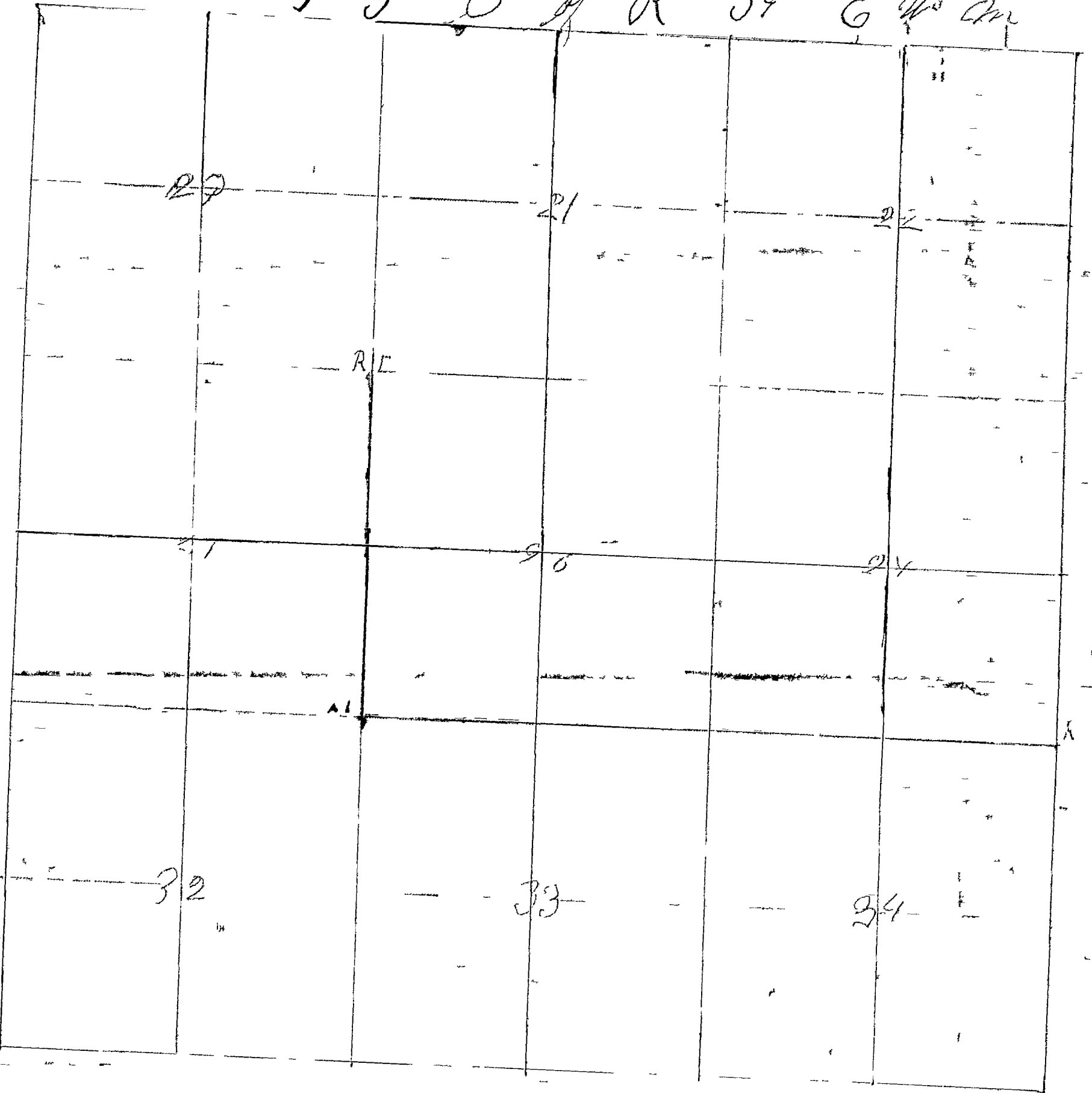
