The undersigned, householders of Union County, Oregon, residing in the vicinity where the hereinafter described road is proposed to be, respectfully petition your Honorable body to lay out, alter and establish a County road within said County on the following line or route, to-wit:

Commencing at a Bridge across dry creek on the Meacham road near Five Point Mill near the N.E. corner of the S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 30 Town 2 South Range 37 E.W.M. Curving from the Starting Point S. E about 20 Rods and under the O. R. & N. R. R. Trussell thence in a N. E. direction and up what is known as Five Point Creek on the most Practical Route through Sections 30 19 18 7 8 and terminating at a Rock Fall situated where the Fox Hill Road crosses Five Point Creek on the N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of S. 4 Town 2 S Range 37 E.W.M.

REPORT OF VIEWERS.

TO THE HONORABLE COUNTY COURT FOR UNION COUNTY, OREGON:

The undersigned viewers heretofore on the 6 day of Nov, 1895, appointed to view and lay out and alter the proposed county road, of which the survey hereto attached is a true and correct description, as petitioned for by W. D. Arnold, et al, beg leave to report that on the 15 day of Nov 1895, in pursuance with said appointment and order, after being duly sworn to faithfully and impartially discharge the duties of said appointment, we proceeded to view out said proposed road for the whole distance thereof, and that in our opinion said proposed road should be laid out and established as a public highway of Union County, Oregon; that the same is practicable and would add to the convenience of the householders residing in the vicinity thereof. We therefore recommend that said proposed road be laid out and declared a public highway of said county.

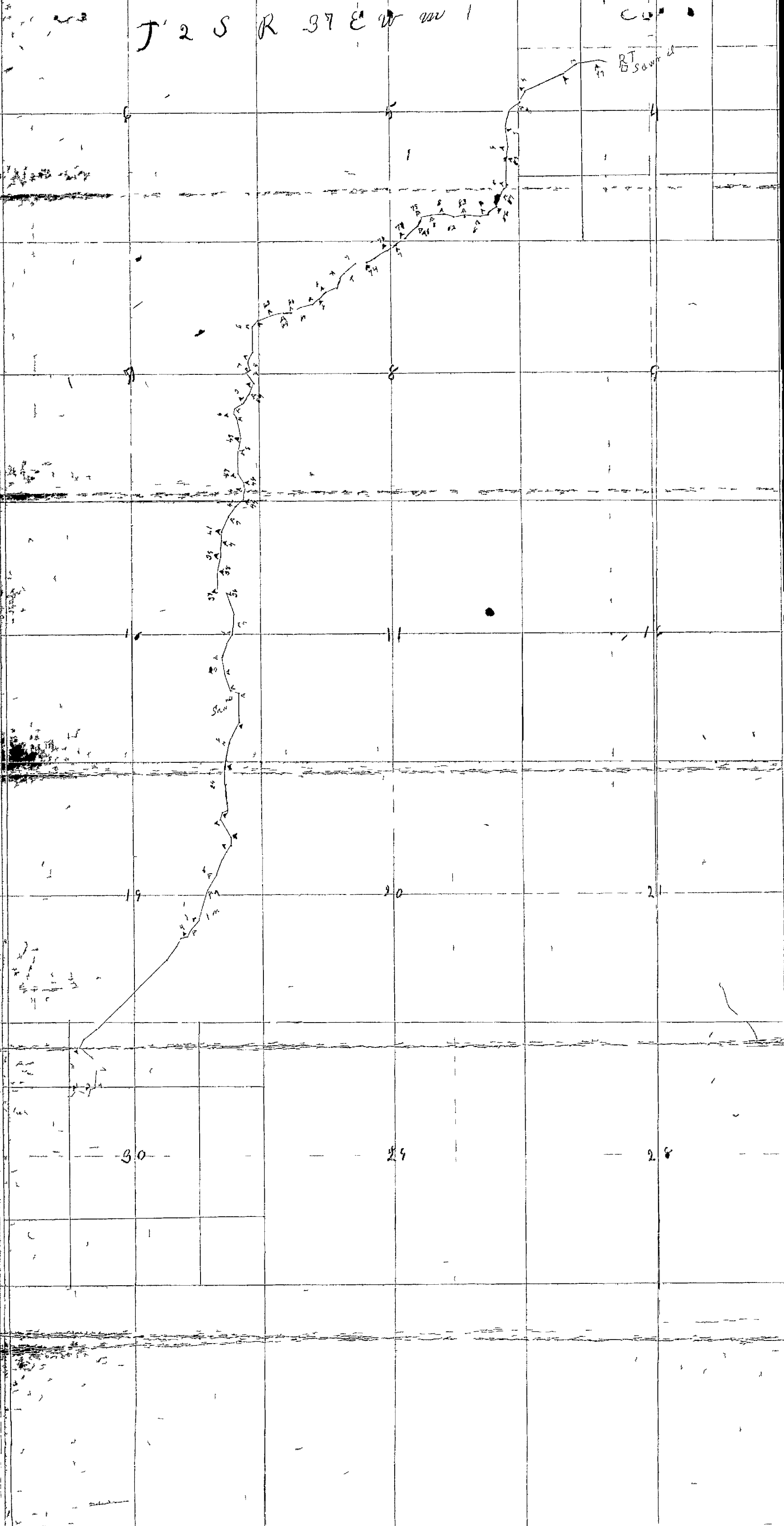

Be it Remembered, that at a Regular Term of the County Court of the State of Oregon for Union County, begun and held at the Court House in the City of Union in said County, and State on Monday the 4th day of November, 1895, and from day to day thereafter during the continuance of said Term, when on Wednesday the 6th day of November, 1895, or Third Judicial Day of said Term, the said County Court opened for the transacting of business with the following officers present, to-wit:

The proclamation of the opening of Court having been made, the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

In the matter of the proposed County Road petitioned for by W. A. Arnold et al.

Came now W. A. Arnold, one of the petitioners for the above named proposed County Road, and presents to the Court the petition of himself and others, praying for the location and establishment of the County Road, described as follows, to-wit: Commencing at a bridge across Dry Creek on the Meacham Road near Iron Point Mill near the N.E. corner of the S.W. 1/4 of the N.W. 1/4 Sec 30, Tp. 7. S.R. 37 E. W. M. running from the starting point N.E. about 70 rods and under the O.R. & N.R.R. Trestle, thence in a N.E. direction up what is known as Iron Point Creek in the most practicable route through Secs. 30, 19, 18, 7th and terminating at a rock pile situated where the Fox Hill Road crosses Iron Point Creek, on the N.E. 1/4 of S.W. 1/4 Sec. 7, S.R. 37 E. W. M. And it appears to the Court that said petition is signed by more than three hundred holders of the County, residing in the vicinity of said proposed road, and that said petition properly specifies the place of beginning, intermediate points and place of termination of said road, and it also factually appearing to the Court that notice has been given by address to owners of land at the place of holding County Court, to-wit: At the Court House in the town of Union.
