Now at this time comes E. F. W. M. owned by your petitioned, E. F. Mills, and cutseff from his other lands about 10 acres of the same.

That said County road No. ______ enters said lands on the south line thereof, about 20 rods east of the southwest corner thereof, and leaves said lands on the west line thereof, about 20 rods north of the said southwest corner thereof, and that the said road as surveyed will practically deprive your petitioner of the use of the said 10 acres of his said lands, so cut off from his other lands as aforesaid.

Your petitioner desires to change the said County Road so as to run west from the point where the same enters the south line of said lands to the corner thereof, thence north to intersect the said road at the point where the same leaves the said lands on the west line thereof, the said road when extraged to occupy 40 feet of petitioner's lands; That said change will place the said road upon as good ground as where the same as surveyed, crosses petitioners lands, and will not materially lengthen the same to injury of the public.

Wherefore your petitioner prays that an order of Court he made allowing him to change the said road as by law required.
