The undersigned householders of Union County, Oregon, residing in the vicinity where the hereinafter described road is to be, respectfully petition your Honorable body to lay out, alter and establish a County Road within said County, on the following line or route, to-wit:

Commencing on the County road at the N. E. Corner of J. A. Walker's place, where a stake is set up & marked "A." Thence South 40 Rods to a tree marked "B." Thence in a Southerly direction to the top of the old grade, where a tree is marked "C." Thence in an Easterly direction about 70 rods to where a stake is set up marked "D." Thence south about 80 rods to where a stake is set up on the Sumnerville, Co. road marked "E."

Said road to be forty feet wide

And in duty bound your petitioners will ever pray, &c.
