In the Matter of Road.
Petition

Now at this time was presented a petition of twelve householders residing in the vicinity and along the route of the following proposed County Road commencing at or near the Store of Cowles & McDaniel thence to run due East one mile to S & E corner of Sec 15 thence $\frac{1}{4}$ mile North, thence East $\frac{1}{2}$ mile, thence on the best route for a road, to terminate at or near the S & E corner of Section (13) thirteen in Township 3 S R 40 E praying for the location of the same, which petition was duly accompanied with a Bond which Bond was duly approved by the Court also with proof of posting of Notices in accordance with law, It is therefore Ordered that D A McAlister Nathan Baker and A H Steward be and they are hereby appointed Viewers, and J L Lewis Surveyor who are to meet at the Store of Cowles & McDaniel on the 30th day of September 1872 and after being duly sworn proceed to view out said route and report their doing at the next term of this Court in November next,

In the Matter of Special
Session of County Court

It appearing to the Court that the Assessor having failed to complete the Assessment Roll so as to make the levy at this term of Court It is therefore Ordered that a Special Term of this Court be held on the 19th day of September 1872 for the purpose of making said levy, and for such other business as may come before the said Court,

Second Judicial day November 12th 1872

Court meets pursuant to adjournment

Due proclamation of the Opening of Court having been made the following proceedings were had

In the Matter of Road
Viewers Report

Now on this day was presented the report of the Viewers heretofore appointed to view out mark and survey a County road commencing at or near Cowles & Mc Daniels Store in Cove Precinct and terminating at or near the S.E. corner of Section 13 in Township Three South of Range Forty East.

Which report is as follows to wit:

We the undersigned appointed by your Honorable body by leave to report the following to wit:

That we met on the 30th day of Sept. 1872 and after being duly sworn proceeded to view out and locate said Road with J. L. Curtis as Surveyor and that we find the route practicable for a road and believe that the Road will be of general benefit to the Citizens living in the vicinity of the Road, all of which together with the Plat and Notes of the Survey is respectfully Submitted. (Signed) D. A. McAlister

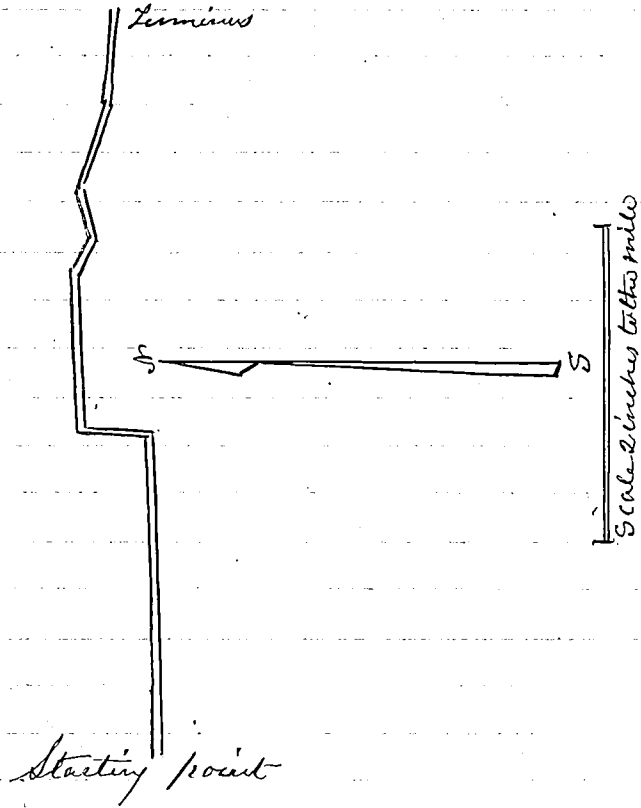

Cowles & McDaniel's Store. Thence E 95 Chns thence N 20° E
Thence E 45 Chns, Thence S 64° E 10 Chns Thence N
84° E 15 Chns. Thence S 70° E 25 Chns, Thence S 85° E 30 Chns
to the terminus at a double Pino tree standing near
the S line of Sec 13 Township 3 S Range 40 E each of
the trees being marked R and T. Whole distance
3 Miles.
