The undersigned viewers heretofore on the 7 day of June, 1897, appointed to view and lay out and alter the proposed county road, of which the survey hereto attached is a true and correct description, as petitioned for by L B Stearns, et al, beg leave to report that on the 19 day of June, 1897, in pursuance with said appointment and order, after being duly sworn to faithfully and impartially discharge the duties of said appointment, we proceeded to view out said proposed road for the whole distance thereof, and that in our opinion said proposed road should be laid out and established as a public highway of Union County, Oregon; that the same is practicable and would greatly add to the convenience of the householders residing in the vicinity thereof. We therefore recommend that said proposed road be laid out and declared a public highway of said county.



Petition for County Road.

To the Honorable County Court, For Union County, Oregon.

The undersigned householders of Union County, Oregon, residing in the vicinity where the hereinafter described road is to be, respectfully petition your Honorable body to lay out, alter and establish a County Road within said County, on the following line or route, to-wit:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of Sec 10, Tp 3, South of Range 40 E.W.M. thence running in an east only direction 1 mile to the S.W. corner of the N.W. quarter of the S.W. quarter of Sec 11 said Tp and Range, thence running South of South easterly with a gradual ascent following a line near now staked out to a point 50 rods east of the Southwest corner of the S.W. quarter of Sec 11 of said Tp and Range, thence running easterly along the Sec line between Secs 11 and 14 two hundred and fifty rods, thence running in a east South easterly direction over the most practical route to a point 10 rods South of the N.W. corner of Sec 13, thence Southerly on the Sec line to a point 40 rods South of said last said corner; thence running easterly one half mile, there terminating, at a point 40 rods South of the N.E. corner of the N.W. quarter of Sec 13 said Tp and Range. Said road to be 40 feet wide, and for the first 80 rods of the distance to be entirely on the North side of said line, the line running east and west through the center of the S.W. 1/4 of Sec 10 of said Township & Range.

D. 1897, respectfully present to said Court a petition praying said Court to lay out, alter and establish a County road within said County on the following line or route, to-wit:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 10 Township 3 South of Range 40 E. W. that at the January term of this Court an order was made cancelling the tax lien charged against Mrs Anna B. Leng, for the year 1894; that at the time the said order was made it was represented to the Court that Anna B. Leng was the owner of lots one and two in Block Eighty-nine, Chaplin's addition to La Choute, and that she was unable to pay the taxes charged against said property without leaving herself destitute and that if she was compelled to pay the said taxes the County would probably have to grant her aid as she would be unable to support herself and family. But it now appears to the Court that there is a mortgage against her said property which is liable to be foreclosed and the property taken away from the said Mrs Anna B. Leng; and that it would be an injustice to the taxpayers of the County to cancel the lien against the said property and that if the said lien is cancelled it would not be a benefit to Mrs Anna B. Leng but would be benefiting the mortgagees of the premises. It is therefore considered and ordered that the order heretofore made at the January term of this Court cancelling the said tax lien and removing the same for the year 1894 be and the same is hereby retracted, disallowed and held for naught.
