South of Range 37 E.W.M., the said tree being on the northeast Quarter of northeast quarter of Section 23 Township 2 South of Range 37 E.W.M, and said road being designated on the County records as road, Numbered 358 and petitioned for by J. This matter came on to be heard at this time on the affidavit of Mary A. Wilson for County aid from which it appears that the said Mary A.
