There will be a petition presented to the County Commissioners at their April term praying the Location of a County road on the following route, to wit

Beginning at or near the residence of Holcomb Bros in Indian Valley running from thence on the most practicable route to Wallowa Valley, terminating at or near the residence of William McCormack in Sand Valley — Union County

Whereas an application has been made to the County Court of Union County Oregon at the April term 1873 to lay out a road and grant the same beginning at or near Halgath Brook in Indian valley running from the place of beginning on the west side to <sup>to Walla valley</sup> both ends, terminating at or near the residence of William McCornack in Sada valley Union County Oregon. Therefore we J. Masterson and J. B. Hubble, - - - an ad hoc jury sworn to the County of Union for the sum of two hundred dollars Concluded that if the plan of the petitioners be permitted to be not granted and allowed then we or either of us will pay all costs and expenses that may be incurred by reason of such review otherwise to remain null and void

Now on this day was read petition praying for a County Road to be located and laid out commencing in Indian Valley at or near the residence of Hollgarth's Brothers, thence on the best route to the Willow Valley, terminating at or near the farm of William McCombs in said Willow Valley, all of which points are in Union County. Which said petition was signed by more than twelve resident householders living on the route of said proposed road which petition was duly accompanied with a bond, which bond was duly approved by the Court also with proof of notices having been duly posted according to law thirty days prior to this time. It is therefore ordered that James Henderson, R. S. Childs and J. S. McCombs be and they are hereby appointed Viewers on said proposed Road, and J. S. Centis Surveyor who are to meet at the house of Hollgarth's Bro<sup>s</sup> on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of June 1873 and proceed to lay out and mark said Road, and report their doings to next term of Court in July.

Court then adjourned until to morrow  
 at 9 O'clock
