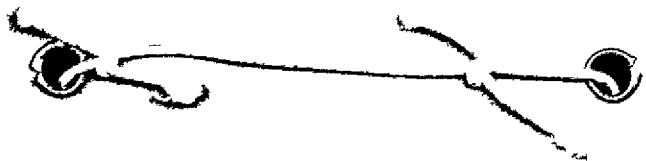

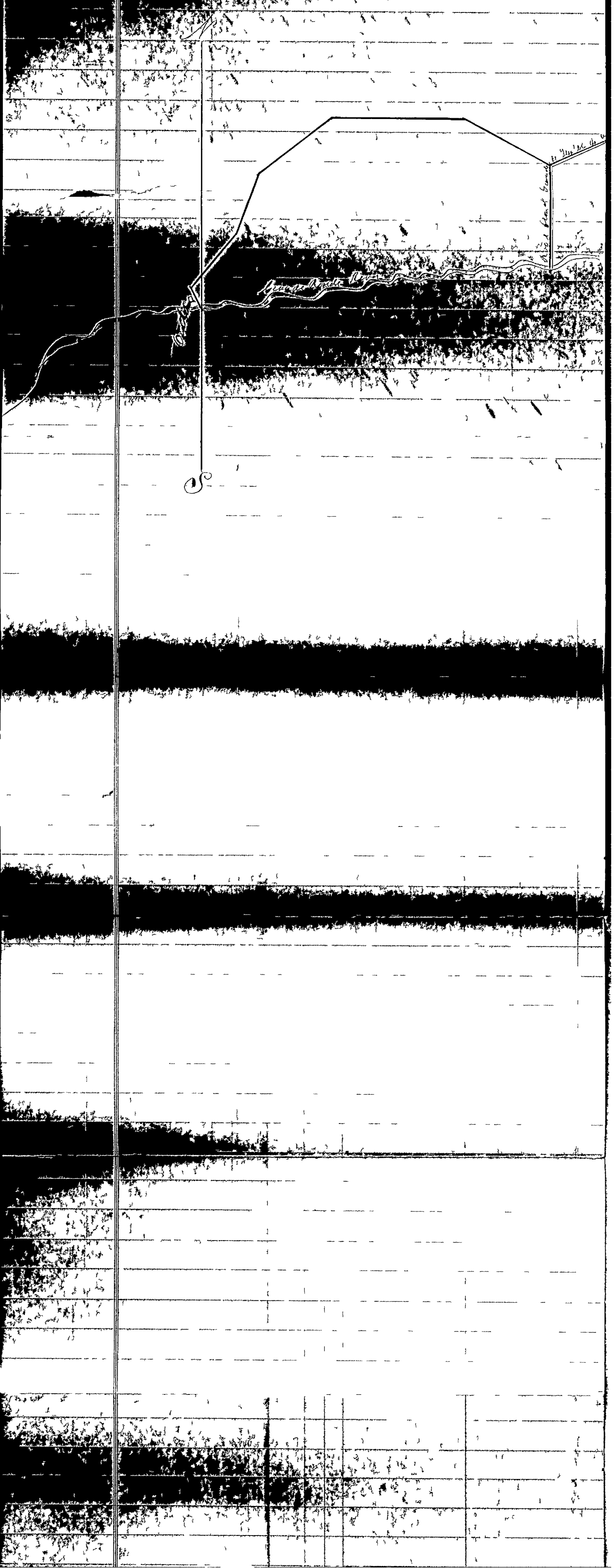

In the matter of a petition for a county Road from the Bridge on Grand Ronde River at Credell to intersect the County Road from La Grande to Teniballs Mills. John Corvies A Gangloff E. C. Coane were appointed viewers and Daniel Chaplin Surveyor. to meet on the 19th day of May 1866 at Credell for the purpose of viewing said Road.

In the matter of a petition for a County Road from the town of Credell ^{the north east corner of the town of 2 1/2 miles} to the ^{the town of Union} ^{the town of Union} Coane F. Hodine Thomas Babbington were appointed viewers and M C Isreal Surveyor to meet on the 24th day of May 1866 at Union for the purpose of viewing said Road

Liquor
License

The Petition of Matthew Rice for license to sell spiritous liquors in less quantities than one quart was received and it appearing that proper notice had been given and Bonds filed It is thereupon ordered that license be granted to said Matthew Rice to sell spiritous liquors in less quantities than one quart for the term of six months from date hereof by the payment of the sum of \$500 as required by law

Billiard
License

It is also ordered upon the application of Matthew Rice that a license be issued to Matthew Rice for keeping a Billiard Table for a term of six months by complying with the law made and provided in such cases
