To the Hon. Commissioner's Court for the  
County of Union State of Oregon:

I A. B Conley do hereby represent to the Court that he is the owner and in the possession of the following described lands in Union County State of Oregon, to-wit: The Northwest quarter of section thirteen and the North-half of section fourteen in Township three South of Range thirty nine East of Willamette Meridian; Also the Southeast quarter of Section eleven in said Township and Range; that the present County road leading from Cove Oregon to LaGrande, Oregon, runs north from the along the line between said sections thirteen and fourteen for about one fourth mile and thence diagonally through the Northeast quarter of said section fourteen to a point near the Northwest corner of said section fourteen and thence along the line of section fourteen west; that I am desirous of changing said county road from the said point at the southeast corner of Northeast quarter of section fourteen as aforesaid, to the point where the same intersects the north line of said section fourteen, as follow to-wit: Commencing at the southeast corner of said section fourteen said Township and Range and thence running west to intersect what is known as the Hunt grade and thence along and over said grade in a northwesterly direction to a point where the said grade intersects the present County road on the section line between sections fourteen and eleven aforesaid, and I hereby respectfully make application to be allowed to make said change in said County road



TO THE HONORABLE COUNTY COURT FOR UNION COUNTY, OREGON:

The undersigned viewers heretofore on the 4 day of January, 1899, appointed to view and lay out and alter the proposed county road, of which the survey hereto attached is a true and correct description, as petitioned for by A B Conley in his own right, et al, beg leave to report that on the 12 day of January, 1899, in pursuance with said appointment and order, after being duly sworn to faithfully and impartially discharge the duties of said appointment, we proceeded to view out said proposed road for the whole distance thereof, and that in our opinion said proposed road should be laid out and established as a public highway of Union County, Oregon; that the same is practicable and would greatly add to the convenience of the householder's residing in the vicinity thereof. We therefore recommend that said proposed road be laid out and declared a public highway of said county.
