

Now on this day was presented a petition of twelve resident house holders, residing in the vicinity of a proposed road for vacating of portion thereof, and location of a new road, praying for the elevation of a part thereof, and changed or altered in front thereof of the County road now located and running through Section 21 and 22 on the 40 acre line of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 21 and NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 22 & 3 S R 38 to be vacated and that the road running North and South from the Island Mills be extended about $\frac{1}{4}$ mile further South, and thence in a South Westly direction about $\frac{1}{4}$ mile, thence due west to intersect the Bluff road, opposite the Barn of A. H. Wallace. Which petition was accompanied by a bond and proof of notices having been duly posted in accordance with law.

It is therefore Ordered that A. H. Wallace

John Bartness and G W Bartness be and they
are hereby appointed Viewers to view out said
Road and Variation part thereof with J L
Curtis as Surveyor who are to meet at the house
of Peter Kuhn on the 22nd day of July 1873. and
proceed in the discharge of their duties, and
Report their doing at the next term of this
Court,

In the Matter of County of

Now on this ^{day}, Came up
for action the petition heretofore presented, which
action had been postponed from term to term
to this time, praying for the location of a
County Road convenience at the North East
corner of James Bartness' field, thence due south
to a point connecting with the road from
Salgrund to the levee in said County, and
to vacate the road from the place of beginning
described in the petition to where the road
now intercepts the same road, Which peti-
tion was signed by twelve or more resident
householders residing in the vicinity of
Sail Road in said County, which petition
was accompanied with a bond approved by
the Court also with proof of notices having
been duly posted according to law.

It is therefore Ordered that D A McAlister
John Bartness and G W Bartness be and
they are hereby appointed Viewers of said
Road and J L Curtis Surveyor, who are to
meet at the house of James R Bartness on
the 22nd day of July 1873 and Report their
proceedings at the next term of this Court,

At a term of the County Court of the County of Union State of Oregon began and held at the Court House in Selma Union on the 3rd day of September AD 1873 there was present Hon. E C Brainard County Judge, John A Childers and J W Kennedy County Commissioners, Arthur Warwick Sheriff and S M Black County Clerk

Due proclamation of the opening of Court having been made, the following proceedings were had;

In the Matter of Roads

Now on this day was presented Report of the Viewers heretofore appointed to view out a proposed alteration in the County road leading from Union to Selma, commencing at a point on said Road known as the North end of Hobbins Land, and running thence Northward one fourth mile to the NE corner of J. B. Baird's land, thence west one half mile, thence North two miles, thence west one mile, thence North one and one half miles, thence westerly to the Bridge on Catherine Creek known as the Hull Bridge. Which Report was read in open court for first time and laid over until tomorrow for further action.

Now at this time was read the second time the Viewers and Surveyors report heretofore appointed to view a proposed alteration in a part of a County Road now located and running through Sec 21 and 22 on the 40 acre line of the N.E. 1/4 S 21 and N.W. 1/4 Sec 22 T 3 S R 38 E be located, and that the road running North and South from the "Island Miles" be extended about $\frac{1}{4}$ mile further South, and turned in a Westward direction about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile, thence due West to intersect the Bluff Road opposite the Barn of H A Wallace, all of which points and places are in Union County Oregon. 
