Now, the condition of the above obligation is such, That, whereas the above named John Graham and Frank Wade, and others, have petitioned the County Court of said County of Union, at the October Term, 1899 thereof, <sup>De Vacate</sup> for a County Road,

beginning at a point 12 rods East of the S.W. corner of Sec. 4 @ 1 N. R. 40 E. 7 N. M.
