I, the undersigned petitioner, do hereby represent that I am the owner and in the possession of the following described lands, situated in Union county, state of Oregon, to-wit: the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter, and the north half of the northeast quarter of the northwest quarter of section 27; the southwest quarter of the southwest quarter; the southeast quarter of the southwest quarter, and the southeast quarter of the ~~southeast~~<sup>north</sup> quarter of the southwest quarter section 22, all in township 6 south, range 39 E. W. M. That there is at present a county road laid out and established upon said lands; that the said road runs diagonally through the southeast quarter of the ~~southeast~~<sup>north</sup> quarter of the southwest quarter and the south half of the southwest quarter of said section 22, and the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter of said section 27. That I am desirous of changing said county road from a point on the section line between sections 27 and 28 to a point about 30 rods southwest of the south end of second street in the town of North Powder, Union county, Oregon, and have the same located as follows, to-wit:

the field notes of said survey:

18.08 chs South 29° West from the Sec. Con to Sec. 21-22-22-28 T. 6 S.  
R. 39 E. N.W. M. at Rock marked R in present County Road Thence North  
29° East 14.00 chs to Angle 1 a Stake Thence North 20.38.  
chs To Angle 2 a stake, Thence East 27.00 chs to Angle  
3 Stake, Thence North 58° 30' East 4.00 chs to Angle  
4 Stake. Thence North 19° East 5.00 chs to Road  
Terminus a Stake in present trashed road.



Amended Report of Viewers:-

To the Honorable County Court for Union County, Oregon:-

The undersigned viewers heretofore and in the 5th day of March 1900, appointed to view and review the proposed change petitioned for by Andrew Land in the road through his place come now and make this their amended report, that on March 24th 1900, in pursuance with said appointment and order, being duly sworn to faithfully and impartially discharge the duties of said appointment, we proceeded to view out said proposed change in said road the whole distance thereof and beg leave to say:- That we reviewed the ground over which the road is proposed to be turned, and ascertained the distance such road will be increased by the proposed alteration, and find the distance to be as set out severally in the report of the County Surveyor and ~~planum~~ plat and notes attached hereto-and that said distance will be increased about ~~907~~<sup>or 55 Rods</sup> feet by said change; that in our opinion the proposed road will be as useful as the present-and that the said alteration will be as good a road, over as good ground and route as the established road and that the public convenience generally will not be injured by the proposed change-and that in our opinion the prayer of the petitioner is reasonable.
