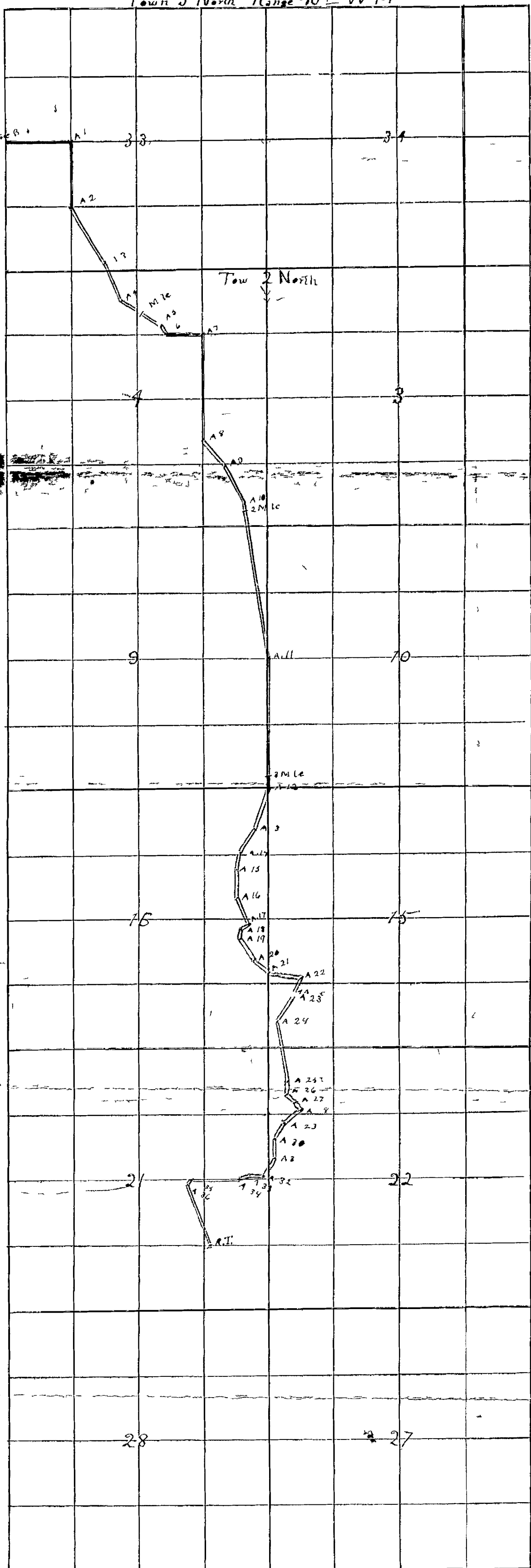

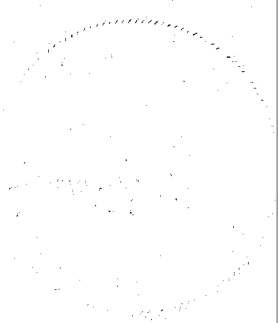

The undersigned viewers heretofore on the 5th day of February, 1902, appointed to view, lay out and alter the proposed county road of which the survey, hereto, attached is a true and correct description, as petitioned for by Cyrus Bush, et al, beg leave to report that on the 20th day of February, 1902, in pursuance with said appointment and order after being duly sworn to, faithfully and impartially discharge the duties of said appointment, we proceeded to view out said proposed road for the whole distance thereof, and that, in our opinions said proposed road should be laid out and established as a public highway of Union County, Oregon. That the same is practicable and would add greatly to the convenience of the householders residing in the vicinity of said road, we therefore recommend that said proposed road be laid out and declared a public highway of said County.

It is further ordered that the report of the viewers be placed on record in this journal, and that the surveyors plat of the proposed road and his field notes of the survey thereof

be placed on record in the books of Plats of County Roads of Union County, Oregon, and that E. Chris Lund for a license to sell malt
liquors in less quantities than one gallon
in the precinct of Cove, Ore }

This matter came on to be heard at this time on the petition of Chris Lund to sell malt liquors in less quantities than one gallon in the precinct of Cove, Union County, Oregon, for a period of six months from the 14th April, 1902, and it appearing to the Court that the petition is signed by a majority of the legal voters of said precinct, and that due notice has been given as is evidenced by the affidavit of publication filed herein, said notice having been published in the LaGrande Chronicle a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in LaGrande, Oregon; that the applicant has paid the treasurer of Union County, the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) and has filed the receipt of the Treasurer with the Clerk of this Court, That no remonstrance or petition against the issue of said license has been filed except a remonstrance of a portion of the citizens of the Cove against the issuance of said license, alleging that said remonstrance contained a greater number of names than the petition, and further that the petition contained a great many names who were not legal residents of the Cove precinct, and the said remonstrance having been fully considered by the Court, and the Court finding that the petition for said license contains a
