Beginning on the County Road as near as practicable to the S.W. corner of the SE<sup>4</sup> SE<sup>4</sup> Sec 19, getting on to the line between the East and West halves SE<sup>4</sup> Sec 19, as near as practicable, Thence North to the NW corner NE<sup>4</sup> SE<sup>4</sup> Sec 19, Thence West to the SW corner NE<sup>4</sup> Sec 19, Thence North to the NW corner SE<sup>4</sup> Sec 18, Thence West to the SW corner NW<sup>4</sup> Sec 18, Thence North to the County Road at the N.W. corner NW<sup>4</sup> Sec 18, T 3 & R 39 E 6 W
