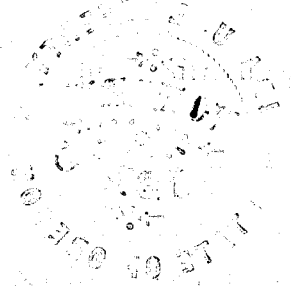

# REPORT OF VIEWERS.



To the Honorable County Court for Union County, Oregon:

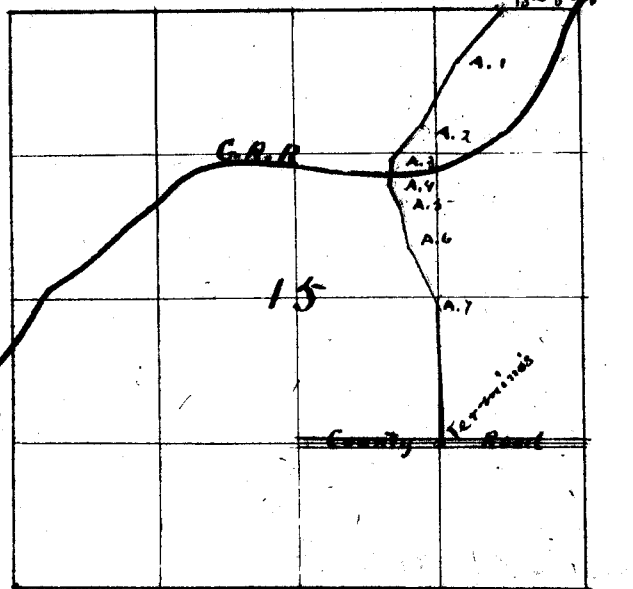
