The undersigned viewers heretofore on the 7th day of January 1903 appointed to view, lay out and alter the proposed county road, of which the survey hereto attached is a true and correct description, as petitioned for by G. O. Holmes, et. al., beg leave to report that on the 26th day of January, 1903, in pursuance with said appointment and order, after being duly sworn to faithfully and impartially discharge the duties of said appointment, we proceeded to view out said proposed road for the whole distance thereof, and that in our opinions said proposed road should not be laid out and established as a public highway of Union county, Oregon. That the same is not practicable and would add nothing to the convenience of the householders residing in the vicinity thereof, we therefore recommend that said proposed road be not laid out and declared a public highway of said county.

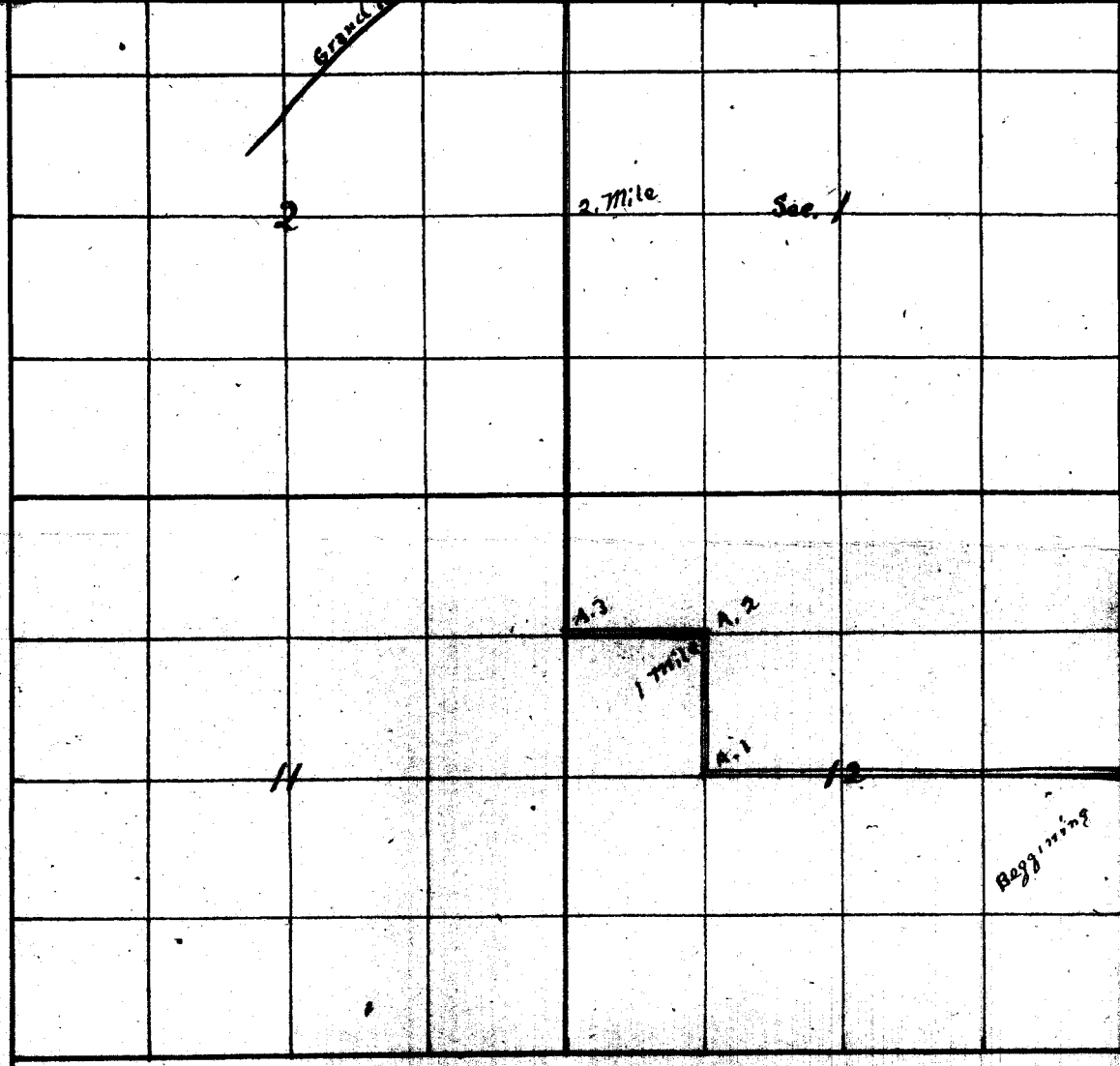
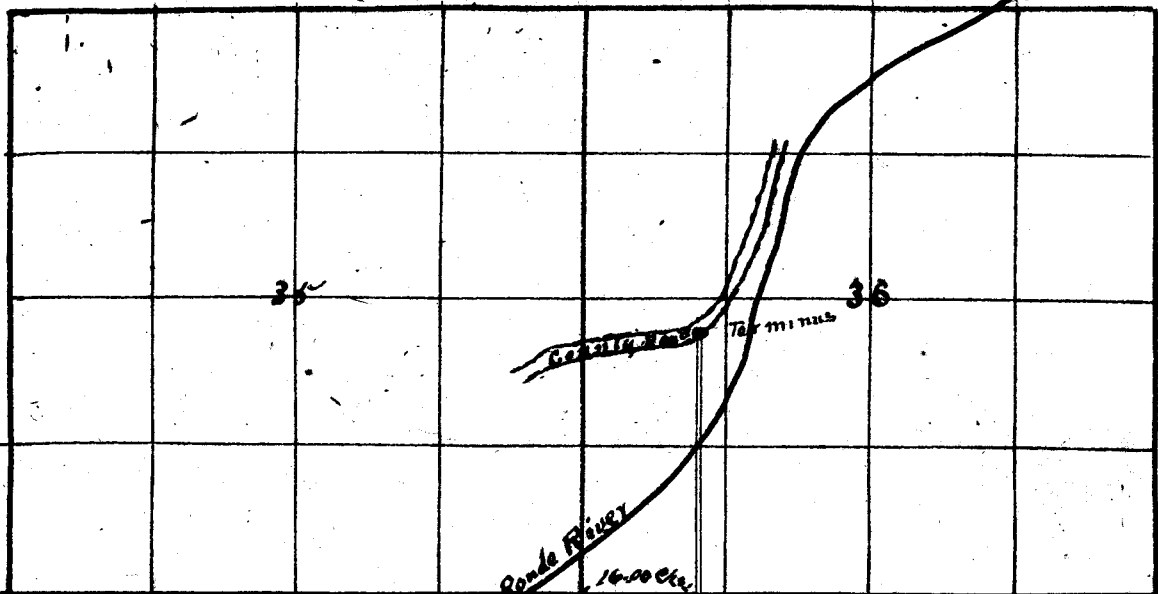
