The undersigned householders of Union County, Oregon, residing in the vicinity where the hereinafter described road is to be, respectfully petition your Honorable body to lay out, alter and establish a County Road within said County, on the following line or route, to-wit: Commencing at the N.W. corner of Sec. 7 Tp. 1 S. R. 40 E. W.M. Union County Or. to Stake "A" thence south about 88 rods to Stake B, thence on an angle of about 30 degrees east of south about 26 rods to stake C, thence about 10 rods on an angle of about 14 degrees east of South to stake D, thence in a southerly direction to stake E, then about 38 rods on an angle of about 34 degrees east of south to stake F, thence to the South east corner of the S.W. 1/4 of the N.W. 1/4 of Sec. 7 Tp. 1 S. R. 40 E. 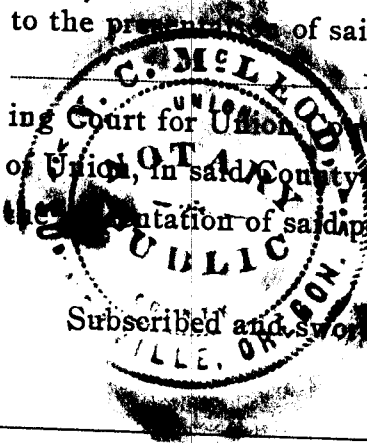

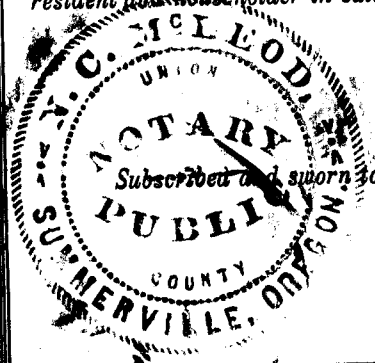
