To the Hon. County Court of Union County, Oregon:

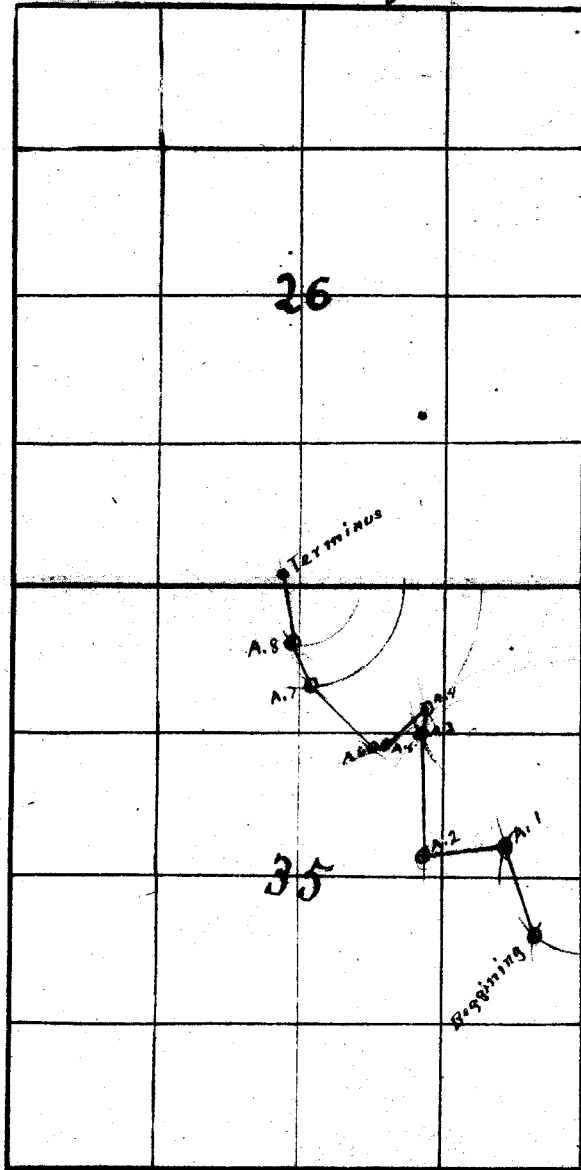
I, the undersigned, County Surveyor, appointed to survey the county road proposed by C. Caldwell et al., beg leave to report that on the 22nd day of May 1905 ~~189~~, in pursuance of said appointment and order, I Surveyed said proposed road for the whole distance thereof, the following being the field notes of said survey:

Cor. between Sections 35-36 T. 2 S. R. 37 E. at a stake marked 1" in

stake 2" Rock; Then S. $81^{\circ}30'$ W 10.60 chs to A. 2, stake 3 Then N. 1° W

The following, among other proceedings, at the County Court, in and for Union County, Oregon, to-wit:

In the matter of

the proposed petitioned for by C. Sealwell, et al.

Comes now one of the petitioners for the above named proposed County

Road, and presents to the Court the petition of himself and others, praying for the location and establishment of a County Road, described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at Robbs road at stake marked No 1, located

in NE 1/4, Sec 38, Tp 2 S. R. 37, E., W. M., one hundred rods north-westerly from the railroad crossing of the Oregon Railway and Navigation Company, thence northwesterly over the most practical route about 60 rods to stake marked No 2, thence westerly over the most practical route about 24 rods to stake marked No 3, located at the corner of the canyon, thence up the canyon over the most practical route about ninety rods to stake marked No 4, thence across the canyon and back down the same over the most practical route about 26 rods to stake marked No 5, thence in a northwesterly direction around the hillside and over the most practical route about One Hundred Ten rods to the intersection of said Robbs Road at the Pine tree, based and marked "No 6 Terminus" same being three rods northwesterly direction from Landis house and situated in the Northwest corner NE 1/4, Sec 38, Tp 2 S. R. 37, E., W. M.

And it appearing to the Court that said petition is signed by more than twelve householders of this county, residing in the vicinity of said proposed road, and that said petition properly specifies the place of beginning, intermediate points and place of termination of said road, and it satisfactorily appearing to the Court that notice has been given by advertisement posted at the place of holding County Court, to-wit: At the Court House in the town of Union, County of Union, State of Oregon, and also in three public places in the vicinity of said proposed road, to-wit:

One on a ^{stake} post at the beginning of the proposed road, one about the center ~~of the proposed road~~ ~~of the proposed road~~ at the proposed road on a tree, and one near the terminus of said road on old Landis Cabin

for more than thirty days immediately prior to the presentation of said petition to this court, notifying all persons concerned that application would be made to this Court at the present session of this Court: and that the notices so posted were in due form and duly signed by the petitioners, and that a bond for the cost of this proceeding has been duly given.

It is Therefore Ordered that J. W. White, Ed Burke and B. Logan

be appointed Viewers of said road, and that Arthur Curtis be appointed Surveyor of said road, and that they meet at beginning of said proposed road on the 22nd day of May 1908, at the hour of 9 o'clock A. M., and after qualifying, to view, survey and lay out said road according to law.
