

This matter came on to be heard at this time on the report of the viewers filed herein, and on the remonstrances against the vacation of the road and on the opinion of the District Attorney filed herein.

And it appearing to the Court that there are mineteen names on the petition for the vacation of the road described as follows: - Commencing at a point 8 chains west of the S.E. Corner of Section 2, Tp. 1, S.R. 38, E. W. M. at a rock set in the ground marked "R" thence running north 21° west 42.15 chains to a rock, Angle 1, thence running north 31° west 10.06 chains to a rock marked Angle 2, thence running north 35° west 21.50 chains to a rock marked R. T. which is set in the center of the County Road at a point on the subdivision line 12.54 Chains south of the quarter section corner on the north side of Section 2, Tp. 1, S.R. 38, E. W. 


