# PETITION FOR COUNTY ROAD.



TO THE HONORABLE COUNTY COURT, FOR UNION COUNTY, OREGON:

The undersigned freeholders, of Union county, Oregon, residing in the road district where the hereinafter described road is proposed to be, respectfully petition your Honorable body to lay out, alter and establish a County Road within said county, on the following line, or route, to-wit:

*Requining at a point on the County road leading from the City of Union to LaGrande known as the Valley Road, at the SE corner of the NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Sec. 27 Tp. 3 SR 39 EWM, running thence west through the center of Secs 27 and 28 Tp. 3 SR 39 EWM to a stake about 1/4 of a mile east of the SW corner of the NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Sec. 28 Tp. 3 SR 39 EWM, thence northwesterly about 1/6 of a mile to a stake on the Sec. line between Secs 28 and 29 Tp. 3 SR 39 EWM, about 1/7 of a mile north of said SW corner of the NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Sec 28 Tp. 3 SR 39 EWM, thence north on the Sec. line between said Secs. 28 and 29 to the NW cor. of said Sec. 28 Tp. 3 SR 39 EWM, intersecting County road, No. 215 at said NW corner of said Sec. 28 and there terminating. And to vacate all that portion of County roads Nos. 51 and 215 between the SE corner of the NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Sec. 27 and the NW corner of Sec. 28 Tp. 3, SR 39 EWM.*



BOND OF ROAD PETITIONERS.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, J. F. Weaver and \_\_\_\_\_, of the County of Union and State of Oregon, are held and firmly bound unto said county of Union, in the full sum of ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) the payment of which, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators firmly by these presents.

Signed this 4th day of November, A. D., 1903.

Now, the conditions of the above obligation is such, that whereas F. J. Wilson and others, have petitioned the County Court of said

county of Union, at the November term, 1903, thereof, for a County Road, described in the petition and notice hereto annexed, as follows: Requiring at a point on the County

road leading from the City of Union to La Grande known as the Valley road at the SE corner of the NW 1/4 of Sec. 27 T. 3 R. 39 E. 1/4 M. running thence west through the center of Secs. 27 and 28 T. 3 R. 39 E. 1/4 M. to a stake about 1/4 of a mile east of the SW corner of the NW 1/4 of Sec. 28 T. 3 R. 39 E. 1/4 M. thence north westerly about 1/4 of a mile to a stake on the Sec. line between Secs. 28 and 29 T. 3 R. 39 E. 1/4 M. about 1/2 of a mile north of said SW corner of the NW 1/4 of Sec. 28 T. 3 R. 39 E. 1/4 M. thence north on the Sec. line between said Secs. 28 and 29 to the NW cor. of said Sec. 28 T. 3 R. 39 E. 1/4 M. intersecting County road No. 215 at said NW corner of said Sec. 28 and thence terminating and to vacate all that portion of County roads Nos. 51 and 215 between the SE corner of the NW 1/4 of said Sec. 27 and the NW corner of Sec. 28 T. 3 R. 39 E. 1/4 M.

# REPORT OF BOARD OF COUNTY ROAD VIEWERS.

To the Honorable County Court for Union County, Oregon :

The undersigned Board of County Road Viewers, heretofore on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of Nov, 1903, instructed to view, lay out and alter the proposed county road, of which the survey hereto attached is a true and correct description, as petitioned for by F. S. Wilson et al., beg leave to report that on the 23 day of November 1903, in pursuance with said order, we proceeded to view out said proposed road for the whole distance thereof, and that in our opinions said proposed road should be laid out and established as a public highway of Union County, Oregon; that the same is practicable and would add \_\_\_\_\_ to the convenience of the householders residing in the vicinity thereof. We therefore recommend that said proposed road be laid out and declared a public highway of said county and that portion of County Road No 514 215 between the S corner of the NW 1/4 of Sec 2, T 7 N, R 39 E, and the NW corner of Sec 28 T 7 N, R 39 E, be located.

To the Hon. County Court of Union County, Oregon:

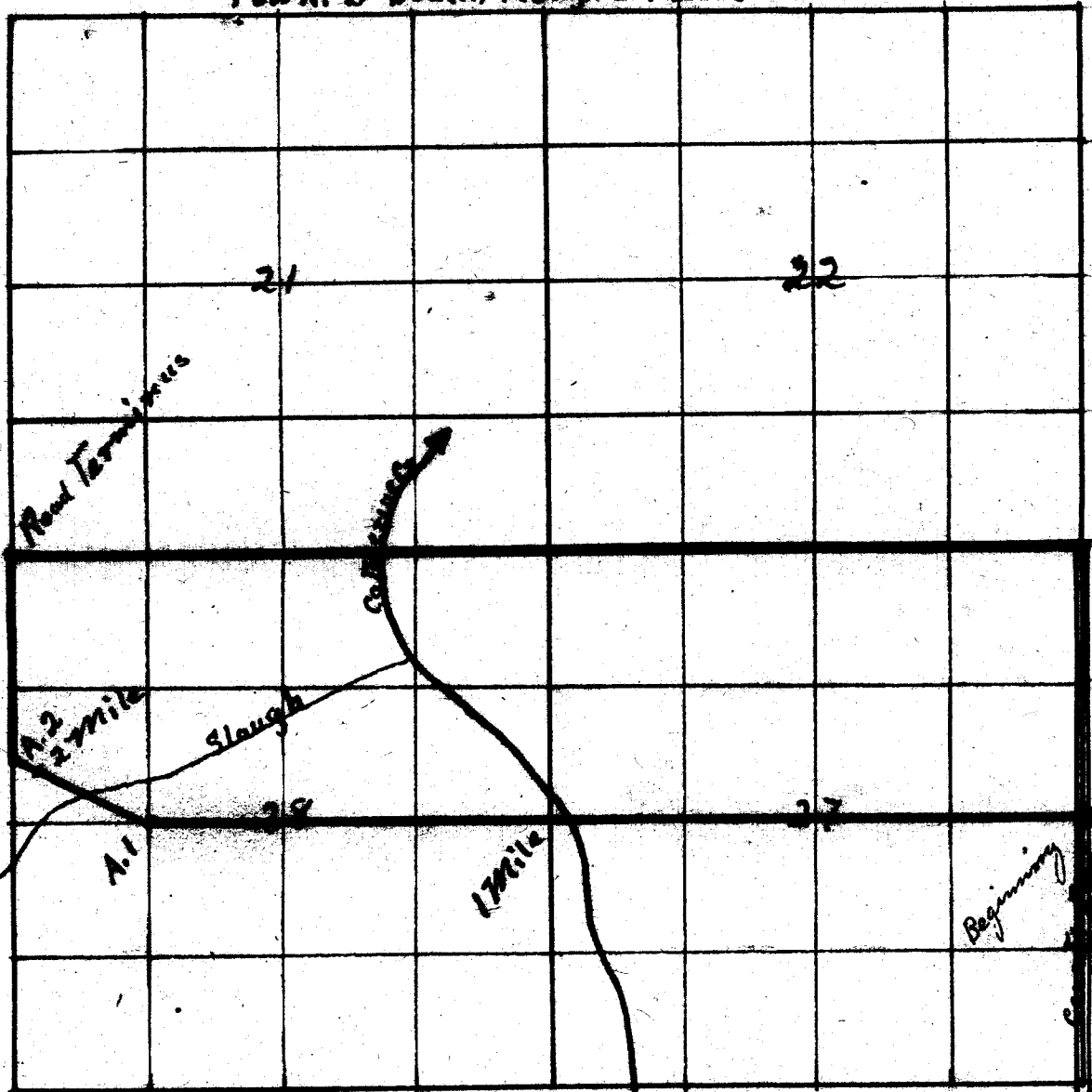
I, the undersigned, County Surveyor, appointed to survey the county road proposed by J. S. Wilson et al., beg leave to report that on the 23 day of November <sup>1903</sup>~~189~~, in pursuance of said appointment and order, I Surveyed said proposed road for the whole distance thereof, the following being field notes of said survey:

Beginning at a stake marked R. set at a point 30 feet West of the S.E. Cor. of the N.E. 1/4 of Sec. 27, T. 3 S. R. 39 E. W.M. Thence West 80 chains set 1 Mile post. Then West 60 chains to Angle 1 a stake Then North 64° West, 23 chains to angle 2 a stake Then North on S. ee. line 30.07 to N.W. Cor. Sec. 28 T. 3 S. R. 39 E. W.M. a rock set in ground marked R.T. and terminate, all points in petitioned were met by survey of road
