

This matter came on to be heard at this time on the application of Mike Royes for the redemption of Lots 17, 18, 23 & 24, Blk 4, Town of Imbler, Oregon, from tax sale thereof to Union County for deleinquent taxes for the year 1896; from which it appears that the petitioner is the owner of the said described lots; that the said lots together with other les were assessed to the Union Land Company afor the year 1896 and that the taxes thereon for said year were not paid; that thereafter said lots were sold for delinquent taxes for the said year and that Union County became the purchaser thereof; that the petitioner is desirous of redeeming said lots from sale thereof to Union County and is willing to pay the pro-rate taxes, penalty and costs chargeable to the lands taxed to the said Union Land Company for the year 1896, and it furter appearing to the Court that it would be to the best interests of the County to accept said tender in redemption of said lots from sle thereof to Union County. R. 40 E. W. M., at a point on the county road at a stake marked "A" about 85 yards south and 60 yards west of the NE corner of said lot, thence running east about 185 yards to a stake marked "B", thence north 25 yards, thence N.W. or nearly so about 225 yards to stake "C" about 100 yards north and 50 yards west of above named corner, thence northeast, intersecting the line between secs. 10 and 11 and continuing north along said section line to the SW. corner of the MW. quarter of SW. quarter, sec. 2,
