

It is therefore considered and ordered that the clerk of this court be, and he is hereby instructed to issue a warrant on the General Fund of the County in favor of the following named indigent persons for the amount set opposite their names, viz:

Comes now B.F. Horrell, one of the peti-

tioners for the above named proposed County Road, and presents to the Court the petition of himself and others, praying for the location and establishment of a county road, described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the North bank of the Looking Glass River 40 rods from the NE core of the NE. 1/4 of the SW.1/4 of Sec. 29, tp. 3, N?R. 40 E.W.M. at a rock marked "R" in Union County, Oregon. Thence in a Northerly direction on the most practicable route to the section line 25 rods from the NE. corner of Sec. 17, in Tp. 3, N.R. 40, E.W.M. Thence in a Northerly direction on the most practicable route to the NE. cor. of Sec. 32, Tp. 4, N.R. 40, E.W.M. terimus. All in Union County, Oregon.

And it appearing to the Court that said petition is signed by more than twelve free-1 holders of this County, residing in the road district where the hereinbefore described road is proposed to be, and that said petition properly specifies the place of beginning, intermediate points and place of termination of said road, and it satisfactorily appearing to the court that notice has been given by advertisement posted at the place of holding County Court, to-wit: At the Court House, in the town La Grande, County of Union, State of Oregon, and also in three public places in the vicinity of said proposed road, to-wit:

One on the County Bridge on the Looking Glass River on the County Road in Section 29, Tp. 3, N.R. 40, E.W.M.

North side of a large pine tree. Comes now M. Burnaugh, Supervisor of R.D.#35, and files his bond as such and asks the Court to approve the same.

It appearing to the Court that the bond is in all things regular and according to law,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the bond be, and the same is hereby approved.

And it appearing to the Court that said Board of County Road Viewers report favorably thereon, and recommend that said proposed road be established as a County Road and be declared a public highway of Union County, Oregon, and the Court being satisfied a from the report of the Board of County Road Viewers that such road will be of public utility the report of the viewers being favorable thereto, and all of the files and records of said proceedings having been submitted to the District Attorney, who had advised this Court as to the legality of said proceedings,

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED AND ORDERED BY THE COURT that the report of the Board of County Road Viewers be placed on record of this journal and that the Suveyor's profile and plat of the proposed road and his field notes of the survey thereof be placed on record in the Book of Plats of County Roads of Union Co., Oreg. and upon the payment into this Court, by the petitioners the sum of \$25.00 damages as assessed by the Board of County Road Viewers, said proposed County Road shall be declared a public highway of Union County, Oregon, and ordered opened up and placed in repair for travel according to law, and that P.A. McDonald Road Supervisor of Road District No. 37, the same being the road district in which said road is located, be furnished with a copy of the petition herein, and a copy of this decree, and ordered to open up said road and place the same in repair for travel.

And it appearing to the Court that said petition is signed by more than twelve freeholders of this county, residing in the road district where the hereinbefore described road is proposed to be, and that said petition properly specifies the place of beginning, intermediate points and place of termination of said road, and it satisfactorrly appearing to the court that notice has been given by advertisement posted at the place of holding County Court, to-wit: At the Court House, in the town of La Grande, County of Union, State of Oregon, and also in three public places in the vicinity of said proposed road, to-wit: One on the County Bridge on the Looking Glass River on the County road in Section 29, T. 3, N.R. 40, E.W.M.; One on the Shotte Brance in Section 30 T. 3 Range 40 E.W.M. on the County Road on the North side of a Large pine tree; one at the farm of Dennis McCullough on the public highway on the North side of a large pine tree, all in Union County, Oregon, for more than thirty days immediately prior to the presentation of said petition to this Court, notifying all persons concerned that application would be made to this Court, at the present session of this court, and that notices so posted were in due form and duly signed by the petitioners, and that a bond for the cost of this proceeding has been duly given, which has approved by this Court.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, That Arthur Curtis, County Surveyor, and B. Logsden and E.B. Morelock, constituting the Board of County Road Viewers, be, and they are hereby directed to meet at the beginning of said proposed road on the 18" day of July, 1905, at the hour of 10 o'clock A.M., or within five days thereafter and proceed to survey, view and lay out said road according to law
