



This matter came on to be heard at this time on the report of County Road Viewers for a second reading, as provided by law, said report being in words following, to-wit:

REPORT OF BOARD OF COUNTY ROAD VIEWERS.

To the Honorable County Court of Union County, Oregon:

The undersigned Board of County Road Viewers heretofore on the Fifth day of July, 1906, instructed to view, lay out and alter the proposed County Road, of which the survey hereto attached is a true and correct description, as petitioned for by William Wiggins et al., beg leave to report that on the 24th day of July, 1906, in pursuance of said order, we proceeded to view out said proposed road for the whole distance thereof, and that in our opinions said proposed road should be laid out and established as a public highway of Union County, Oregon; that the same is practicable and would add greatly to the convenience of the householders residing in the vicinity thereof. We therefore recommend that said proposed road be laid out and declared a public highway of said County and that by the location of said road the property of W. B. Hindman will be damaged to the amount of Four acres of ground at \$5.00 per acre, total \$20.00 and one mile of fencing costing \$100.00 and underground passage costing \$30.00, Thirty Dollars, a total damage of One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00)

And said report of the Board of County Road Viewers having been now publicly read in open Court on two several days of the present term of the Court, and it appearing to the Court that said Board of County Road Viewers report favorably thereon, and recommend that said proposed road be established as a county road and be declared a public highway of Union County, Oregon, and all the proceedings herein having been regular and according to law, and no remons trance or claim for damages having been filed herein, except claim of W.B. Hindman for the sum of \$500.00 as damages by reason of the

location of said proposed road, and there having been no cause shown why this proposed road should not be declared a public highway and ordered opened according to law, and the Court being satisfied from the report of the Board of County Road Viewers that such road will be of public utility; the report of the viewers being favorable thereto,

Now at this time this matter came on for consideration before the Court, and it appearing to the Court that the various officers of Union County, Oregon, have been ordering and purchasing supplies, books and stationery for their respective offices without first making application to the County Court or Judge thereof or obtaining from said Court the privilege of ordering or buying such supplies, and it further appearing to the Court that it would be to the best interest of Union County to require each official to first make a requisition and obtain the consent of said Court or Judge thereof for the purchasing or buying the necessary supplies, and the Court being fully advised in the premises,

It is therefore CONSIDERED and ORDERED by the Court that each official of Union County, Oregon, be and he is hereby required to make application to the County Court of said County and obtain permission for the ordering or purchasing of any and all supplies to be used by them in their respective offices, and no order shall be given or any such supplies purchased without first obtaining such consent or permission from said Court. And if any of such supplies or such stationery shall be purchased or bought without first complying with the foregoing conditions, the County Court will refuse payment of all claims presented for such supplies, and each County official will be held personally liable for the supplies or stationery so purchased or Ordered by him.

It is further CONSIDERED and ORDERED that the Clerk of this Court be and he is hereby instructed to furnish each County Official with a certified copy of this order.

Logsdon, a member of the Board of County Road Viewers, are otherwise occupied and cannot attend to the duties as such officers, and that it is necessary that temporary members of said Board be appointed and served as such, during the pleasure of the Court.

And it further appearing to the Court that C.R. Thornton and Eli Bair ere capable persons.

It is therefore ORDERED that C.R. Thornton be appointed temporary County Surveyor and Eli Bair be appointed temporary member of the Board of County Road Viewers to serve as such during the pleasure of the Court.

In the Matter of the County Road petitioned for by William Wiggins, et al.

Now at this time this matter came on to be heard upon the application of the petitioners herein for assistance from the County in paying the damages sustained by the establishment of said proposed road. And it appearing to the Court that heretofore the Board of County Road Viewers found that the property owners were damaged thereby to the extent of \$150.00. And it further appearing to the Court that the petitioners will be to a great expense in placing said proposed road in proper condition for travel, and that the road will be of great convenience to the public in general, and that it would be proper that said petitioners have some assistance from the County.

It is therefore CONSIDERED and ORDERED that the Court appropriate the Sum of \$150.00 for the purpose of placing said road in proper condition for travel, and that the County Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to issue a warrant on the General Road Fund of the County payable to William Wiggins, one of said petitioners. It is further ORDERED that said petitioners be and they are hereby required to build all bridges on said proposed road and to keep said road in proper condition for travel for the period of one year.
