

This matter ^{on} came to be heard at this time on the report of the Board of County Road Viewers for a second reading, as provided by law, said report being in words following to-wit:

REPORT OF BOARD OF COUNTY ROAD VIEWERS.

To the Honorable County Court of Union County, Oregon:

The undersigned Board of County Road Viewers heretofore on the fourteenth day of August 1906, instructed to view, lay out and alter the proposed county road, of which the survey hereto attached is a true and correct description, as petitioned for by George Palmer Lumber Co. et al, beg leave to report that on the 24th. day of August 1906, in pursuance with said order, we proceeded to view out said proposed road for the whole distance thereof, and that in our opinions said proposed road should _____ be laid out and established as a public highway of Union County, Oregon; that the same is practicable and would add _____ to the convenience of the householders residing in the vicinity thereof. We therefore recommend that said proposed road be _____ laid out and declared a public highway of said county _____

And said report of the Board of County Road Viewers having been now publicly read in open court on two several days of the present term of the court, and it appearing to the court that said Board of County Road Viewers report favorably thereon, and recommend that said proposed road be established as a county road and be declared a public highway of Union County, Oregon, and all the

proceedings herein having been regular and according to law, and no remonstrance or claim for damages having been filed herein

and there having been no cause shown why this proposed road should not be declared a public highway and ordered open according to law, and the court being satisfied from the report of the Board of County Road Viewers that such road will be of public utility; the report of the viewers being favorable thereto, and all the files and records of said proceedings having been submitted to the District Attorney, who has advised this court as to the legality of said proceedings, it is therefore considered and ordered by the court that the report of the Board of County Road Viewers be placed on record in this journal, and that the surveyor's profile and plat of the proposed road, and his field-notes of the survey thereof be placed on record in the Book of Plats of County Roads of Union County, Oregon, and that said proposed road be declared a public highway of Union County, Oregon, and ordered opened up and placed in repair for travel according to law, and that E. Z. Carbine Road Supervisor of Road District No. 20, the same being the road district in which said road is located, be furnished with a copy of the petition herein, and a copy of this decree and ordered to open up said road and place the same in repair for travel.

FOURTH JUDICIAL DAY.

TUESDAY, AUGUST 14th, 1906.

Court met pursuant to adjournment.

Present: Same officers as on Last Judicial Day.

Due proclamation of the opening of Court having been made, the Journal of the Last Day's proceedings was read, approved and is here now signed.

Thereupon the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

In the Matter of the proposed County Road petitioned for by The George Palmer Lumber Company.

Now at this time this matter came on to be heard upon a deed being filed in this Court by Kate L. Hanley and Carrie L. Rynearson, dedicating to Union County, Oregon, for the purpose of a County Road, a strip of land sixty feet wide off the West side of the East one half of the S.E. Quarter, Sec. 31, Tp. 2, South of Range 38, E.W.M., commencing at the North end of Marion Street, in Riverside Addition to the City of La Grande, and running thence North to the County Road running East and West through said premises above described.

And it appearing to the Court that the said deed now on file in this Court is properly executed and said above described lands so deeded to Union County, is free from all encumbrances and that it would be to the best interests of the public that said proposed road be laid out and established through said above described lands.

It is therefore ORDERED, that Arthur Curtis, County Surveyor, and B. Logsdon and Thomas Brasher, constituting the Board of County Road Viewers, be and they are hereby directed to meet at the beginning of said proposed road, on the 24th day of August, 1906, at the hour of 9 o'clock A.M., or within five days thereafter and proceed to survey, view and lay out said road according to law.

In the Matter of the application of E.C. Berry for Liquor License in South Elgin Precinct.

Now at this time this matter came on to be heard upon the petition of E.C. Berry for an order of the Court granting him a license to sell spirituous and malt liquors in less quantities than one gallon in South Elgin Precinct, Union County, Oregon.

And it appearing to the Court that a remonstrance against the issuance of said liquor license has been filed in this Court, said remonstrators appearing by R.H.
