



And gaid report of the Board of County Road Viewers having been now publicly read in open Court on two several days of the present term of the Court, and it appearing to the Court that said Board of County Road Viewers report favorably thereon, and reccommend that said proposed road be established as a County road and be declared a public highway of Union County, Oregon, and all the proceedings herein having been regular and according to law, and no remonstrance or claim for damages having been filed herein, and

there having been no cause shown why this proposed road should not be declared a public highway and ordered opened according to law, and the Court being satisfied from the report of the Board of County Road Viewers that such road will be of public utility; the report of the viewers being favorable thereto, and all the files and records of said proceedings having been submitted to the District Attorney, who has advised this Court as to the legality of said proceedings,

It is therefore CONSIDERED and ORDERED by the Court that the report of the Board of County Road Viewers be placed on record in this Journal, and that the surveyor's profile and plat of the proposed road, and his field notes of the survey thereof be placed on record in the Book of Plats of County Roads of Union County, Oregon, and that said proposed road be declared a public Highway of Union County, Oregon, and ordered opened up and placed in repair for travel according to law, and that L. Klinefelter, Road supervisor of Road District No.30, the same being the road district in which said road is located, be furnished with a copy of this decree and ordered to open up said road and place the same in repair for travel.

Road petitioned for by H. Ruhl, et al.

This matter came on to be heard at this time on the report of the Board of County Road Viewers for a second reading, as provided by law, said report being in words following, to-wit:

REPORT OF BOARD OF COUNTY ROAD VIEWERS.

To the Honoreble County Court of Union County, Oregon;

The under signed, Board of County Road Viewers heretofore on the 6th day of March 1907, instructed to view, lay out and alter the proposed county road, of which the survey hereto attached-is a true and correct description, as petitioned for by H. Ruhl, et al., beg leave to report that on the 22nd day of March, 1907, in purguance of said order, we proceeded to view out said proposed road for the whole distance thereof, and that in our opinions said proposed road should be laid out and established as a public highway of Union County, Oregon; that the same is practicable and would add greatly to the convenience of the householders residing in the vicinity thereof. We therefore recommend that said proposed road be laid out and declared a public highway of said County, and that the old Road between the commencement and intersection of Road running East and West, be vacated, as shown in accompanying plat, attached.
