It appearing to the Court from the affidavit of T.A. Rinehart, Deputy Assessor, that the assessment for the year 1905, was made on a cash value basis, and thereafter all assessment were reduced one half by the Board of Equalization, and the taxes thereon were paid on that basis. And to vacate the public highway in said County, described as follows: Commencing at a point on the Section line 60 feet East of the Southwest corner of the Southeast Quarter of Section 24, Tp.3, S.R. 38, E.W.M., and running thence East on the Section line to a point 30 feet West of the S.E. corner of the S.W. 1/4 of S.E.1/4 of Sec.19, Tp.3, S.R.39, E.W.M.
