Brooks, constituting the Board of County Road Viewers, be and they are hereby directed to meet at the beginning of said proposed road on the 17th day of June, 1907, at ten o'clock A.M. or within five days thereafter and proceed to survey, view and lay out said proposed road, and also to view and survey said proposed vacation of a County Road hereinbefore described, according to law.

Now at this time this matter came on for hearing before the Court, the petitioners not appearing, neither in person nor by attorney, and the remonstrators appearing by C.H. Finn, of counsel.
