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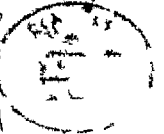

To the Hon County Court of Union Co State of Oregon

We the undersigned Citizens and House holders residing in the vicinity of the proposed road the same being in the County of Union and State of Oregon would respectfully petition the Hon County Court of Union County to locate and establish a county road described as follows (viz) Commencing on Sec 29 T one R 39 E at a road post marked angle thirteen thence south to the North line of Sec 29 T one R 39 E thence east along said North line to the corner of the North west qr of Sec 32 T one R 39 E thence due south one and one quarter mile to the middle of the east line of the North West qr of Sec 5 T Two R 39 E thence south east to the middle of the South West qr of Sec four T Two R 39 east thence east six fms thence south east to the bank of Grande River thence following near the left bank of said River to the corner of the North West qr of the North E qr of Sec 9 T two R 39 E thence south to the eight mile post on the Summerell and Shoemakers point road

The undersigned would furthermore ask the Hon Court to locate so much of the surveyed road as is contained between the eight mile post and the post marked angle thirteen on the Summerell and Shoemaker point road as above described. This part of the road has not been traveled since it was surveyed.

Know all men by these presents that the undersigned am held and firmly bound unto the County of Union State of Oregon in the penal sum of one hundred Dollars as cost and expense that may accrue on locating and establishing the above named road

Second Judicial Day May 14th 1874
 Court met pursuant to adjournment
 Same Officers present as on Yesterday

Due proclamation of the Opening of Court
 having been made the following proceed-
 ings were had,

In the matter of road petition
 for allutation in Road from
 Summerville to Hunderskotts
 Point & Vacating part

Now at this time
 was presented a petition praying for an alter-
 ation, and location of the following described
 Road to wit; Commencing on Sec 29 T one R 39 E
 at a road post marked angle 13, thence South
 to the North line of S 32 T 1 R 39 E, thence East
 along said North line to the Corner of the
 NW 1/4 of Sec 32 T 1 R 39 E, thence South one and
 one quarter mile to the middle of the east line
 of the NW 1/4 of Sec 5 T 2 R 39 E, thence South
 East to the middle of the SW 1/4 of Sec 4 T 2
 R 39 E. thence East sixty five rods, thence South
 East to the bank of Grand Ronde River, thence
 following near the left bank of said River to
 the Corner of the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Sec 9 T 2
 R 39 E thence South to the eight mile post
 on the Summerville and Shoemakers Point Road
 And further asking that so much of the surveyed
 road as is contained between the eight mile post
 and the post marked angle 13 on the Summerville
 and Shoemakers Point Road as above described;
 be vacated. Which petition was duly signed
 by more than twelve resident householders re-
 siding in the vicinity and along the route of
 said proposed road, which petition was

accompanied by a bond which Bond was approved by the Court, also with proof of notices having been posted according to law more than thirty days prior to this date.

It is therefore Ordered that J. S. Hunter, Wm. Moss and W. W. Woodell be and they are hereby appointed Viewers, and Willis Skiff Surveyor, who are to meet at the house of E. S. Nevils on the 29 day of May, 1874 and after being duly sworn to proceed to view out and mark said proposed road and report their proceedings to the next term of this Court.

In the Matter of Road
Viewers Report

Now on this day was read for the second time the Report of the Viewers heretofore appointed to view an alteration in the Road from Big Creek to the Cove, commencing at angle 10 on said road and terminating at the Six Mile post. Which report stated that that the distance was increased about $24\frac{1}{2}$ Chains but is located on a much better ground and recommending that said change be made as of public utility.

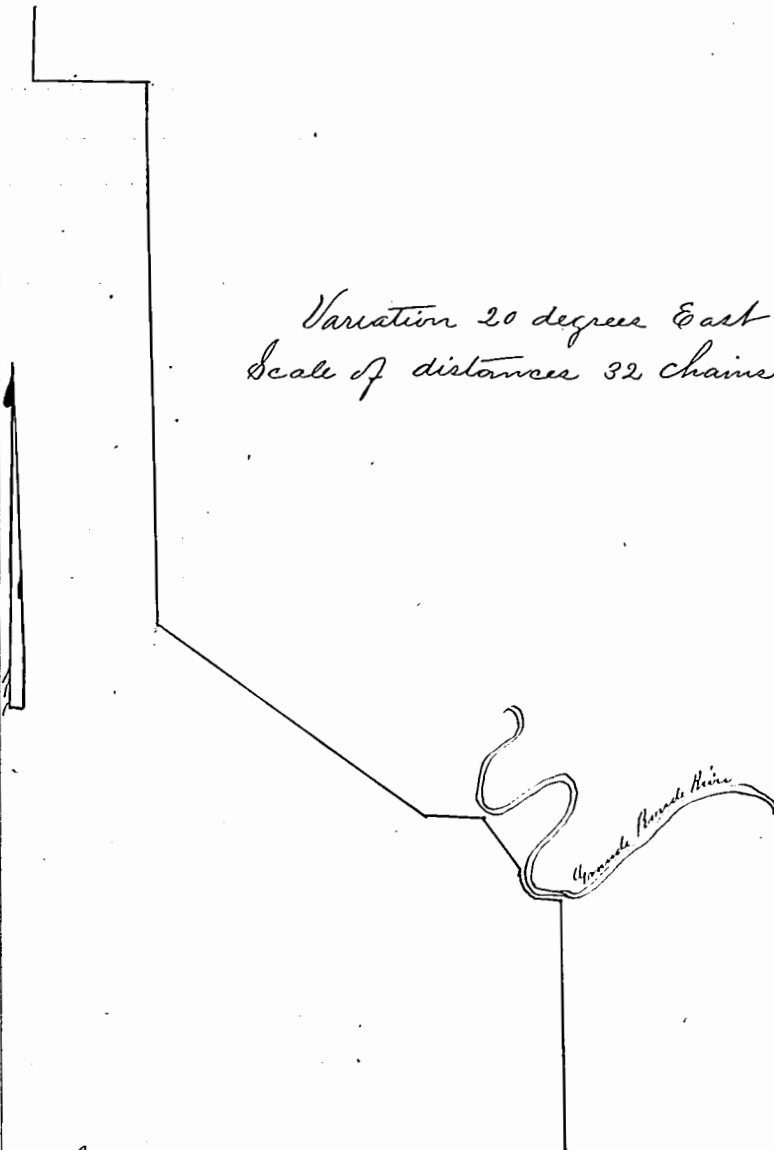
And after due Considerations had
It is Ordered that said Alterations be made in said Road in accordance with the Surveyors plat and field notes hereinafter entered & plat accompanying the same, be and the same is hereby declared to be a public Highway, and Ordered opened and kept in Repair as other public Roads, And further that all that part of said road between the points of starting and termination of said alteration be vacated and annulled.
