

It further expearing to the Court that owing to the fact that the last half of the taxes for not due or collectable until the first Monday in October, 1908, it would be to the best interest of the County to disburse to the various Cities and Towns only one half of the Road Fund approtioned to them for said year, the remainder to be disbursed after the last half of said taxes are paid.
