Hamilton, as surety thereof, and said bond having been approved by the Court it is here now ordered placed on file.

It is therefore ORDERED that Arthur Curtis, County Surveyor, and Thomas Brasher and C.A.Gelloway, constituting the Board of County Road Viewers, be, and they are hereby directed to meet at the farm of R.D.Hamilton, near Perry, on the 15th day of October, 1908, at the hour of ten o'clock in the forenoon of said day, or within five days thereafter, and proceed to survey, view and lay out said road according to law.

In the Matter of the Application of James Moore for Admission to the County Hospital.

Now at this time this matter comes on for consideration of the Court on the application of James Moore for admission to the County Hospital. It appearing therefrom that said indigent person is a resident of Union County, Oregon, having resided therein for several years; that said indigent person is sick and destitute and has no friends or relatives who are able or willing to assist him.

It is therefore CONSIDERED and ORDERED that said indigent be, and he is here by admitted to the County Hospital, and that he receive such medical attention as his condition may require.

In the Matter of the Approval of the Bond of C.T.Bacon, Coroner.

Now at this time comes C.T.Bacon, heretofore appointed Coroner of Union County, Oregon, and files his bond as such. And it appearing to the Court that said bond is in all things regular and according to law, and the sureties thereon being satisfactory

It is therefore CONSIDERED and ORDERED by the Court, that said bond be, and the same is hereby approved and ordered placed on file, and that said appointee enter upon his duties as such upon his taking the oath of office as provided by law.

REPORT OF BOARD OF COUNTY ROAD VIEWERS.

TO THE HONORABLE COUNTY COURT OF UNION COUNTY, OREGON:

The undersigned Board of County Road Viewers heretofore on the 7th day of October, 1908, instructed to view, lay out and alter the proposed county road, of which the survey hereto attached is a true and correct description, as petitioned for by R.D. Hamilton, etal., beg leave to report that on the 15th day of November, 1908, in pursuence with said order, we preoceeded to view out said proposed road for the whole distance thereof, and that in our opinions said proposed road should be laid out and established as a public highway of Union County, Oregon; that the same is practicable and would add to the convenience of the householders residing in the vicinity thereof. We therefore recommend that said proposed road be laid out and declared a public highway of said county.

It is therefore CONSIDERED and ORDERED that said application be, and the same is hereby granted and the County Clerk is hereby directed to issue a warrant for the sum of \$7.08, drawn on the Contingent fund of the County, in favor of said applicants, in refundment of taxes erroneously paid for the year 1907.

Now at this time it appearing to the Court that General Fund Warrant No. 5164, issued to A. Stewart, for the sum of \$6.45, was erroneously issued.
