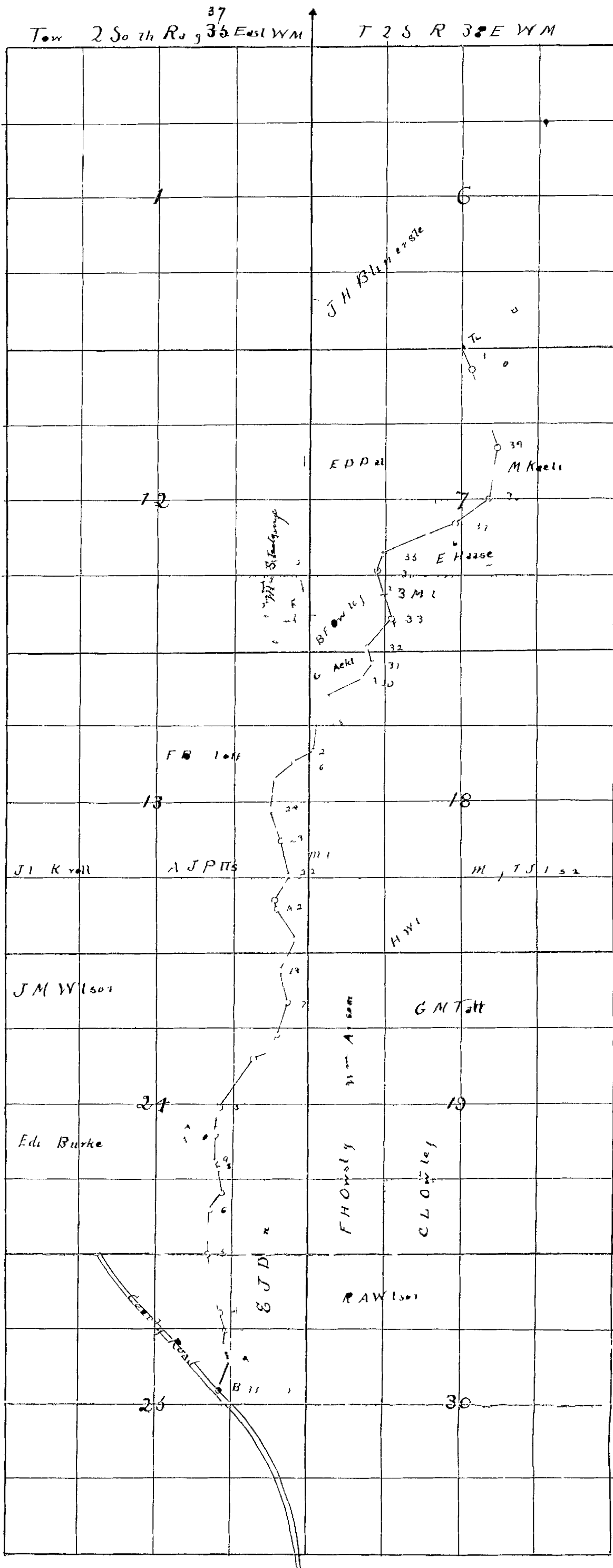

In the Matter of the Application of W.H.Gibson for a Rebate of Taxes for the year 1907.

Now at this time this matter came on for consideration of the Court on the application of W.H.Gibson for a rebate of taxes for the year 1907, from which it appears that said applicant is the owner of Lots 1 to 5 Block 14, in Honan's Addition to La Grande, Oregon. That for said year said property was assessed as being in the City of La Grande, and therefore liable for the special tax that was levied upon all property lying within said city limits. That the special city tax against said property for said year was \$5.60. That on the 6th day of April, 1908, the petitioner paid the first half of his taxes, and the special city tax amounted to \$2.80. That thereafter the applicant discovered that he had paid the city tax charged against his property, when in fact that said real property at the time of the 1907 assessments were made, was not, nor is at the present time, within the limits of the City of La Grande, and therefore is not liable to said special tax.
