Sargent for refund of tax paid for the redemption of lot 10 Block 7 Grandy's Addition to La Grande, Oregon, for the year 1902, the said property having been purchased by the said Charles Cote, the then owner of the property at the sale held by the Sheriff, for the same. And it appearing that the said lot was erroneously included in tax sale, when in fact the same had been properly redeemed from the County, and that the said sale was erroneous on account of the said lot having been offered for sale, when the tax had already been paid, and it appearing that the said Charles Cote at the said Sheriff's sale paid the sum of \$29.02, which sum represented the amount of the delinquent tax, and the costs of levy and sale. And it also appearing that the said Chas. Cote is entitled to interest on said sum of \$29.02, at the rate of 6% per annum from Sept. 12th,1907.

It is therefore ORDERED that the County Clerk is hereby directed to draw a warrant in favor of W.B. Sargent as agent of Chas. Cote, for the sum of \$31.10, the same being for the sum of \$29.02 and interest thereon as aforesaid.

In the Matter of the Application of W.H.Gibson for a Rebate of Taxes for the year 1907.

Now at this time this matter came on for consideration of the Court on the application of W.H.Gibson for a rebate of taxes for the year 1907, from which it appears that said applicant is the owner of Lots 1 to 5 Block 14, in Honan's Addition to La Grande, Oregon. That for said year said property was assessed as being in the City of La Grande, and therefore liabile for the special tax that was levied upon all property lying within said city limits. That the special city tax against said property for said year was \$5.60. That on the 6th day of April, 1908, the petitioner paid the first half of his taxes, and the special city tax amounted to \$2.80. That thereafter the applicant discovered that he had paid the city tax charged against his property, when in fact that said real property at the time of the 1907 assessments were made, was not, nor is at the present time, within the limits of the City of La Grande, and therefore is not liable to said special tax.

It is therefore CONSIDERED and ORDERED by the Court that said application be and the same is hereby granted, and the Clerk of this Court is hereby authorized to issue a warrant for the sum of \$2.50 on the Contingent Fund of the County in favor of said applicant, and to charge the City of La Grande with the sum of \$5.60, the same being the amount of said erroneous assessment.

In the Matter of the Proposed County Road petitioned for By F. H. Owsley, et al.

This matter came on to be heard at this time on the report of the Board of County Road Viewers for a second reading, as provided by law, said report being in words following, to-wit:

REPORT OF BOARD OF COUNTY ROAD VIEWERS.

TO THE HONORABLE COUNTY COURT OF UNION COUNTY, OREGON:

The undersigned Board of County Road Viewers heretofore on the 2nd day of September, 1908, instructed to view, lay out and alter the proposed county road, of which the survey hereto attached is a true and correct description, as petitioned for by F.H.Owsley et al., beg leave to report that on the 10th day of October, 1908, in pursuance with said order, we proceeded to view out said proposed road for the whole distane thereof, and that in our opinions said proposed road should be laid out and established as a public highway of Union County, Oregon; that the same is practicable and would add greatly to the convenience of the householders residing in the vicinity thereof. We therefore recommend that said proposed road be laid out and declared a public highway of said county and by the location of said road there would be a damage to E.J.Dunn, to the amount of (\$100.00) One Hundred Dollars.

And said report of the Board of County Road Viewers having been now publicly read in open court on two several days of the present term of the court, and it appearing to the court that said Board of County Road Viewers report favorable thereon, and recommend that said proposed road be established as a county road and he declared a public highway of Union County, Oregon, and all the proceedings herein having been regular and according to law, and no remonstrance or claim for damages having been filed herein, except the claim of E.J.Dunn for \$100.00 damages, caused by reason of said road crossing over his lands, and there having been no cause shown why this proposed road should not be declared a public highway and ordered open according to law, and the court being satisfied from the report of the Board of County Road Viewers that such road will be of public utility; the report of the viewers being favorable thereto, and all the files and records of said proceedings having been submitted to the District Attorney, who has advised this court as to the legality of said proceedings,

It is therefore CONSIDERED and ORDERED by the Court that the report of the Board of County Road Viewers be placed on record in this journal and that said road be opened up and placed in repair for travel upon the petitioners paying into Court, the sum of \$100.00, the same being the amount of damages assessed by the Board of County Road Viewers.

Thereupon it was ORDERED that Court be now adjourned until Thursday, October 15th, 1908, at 9 o'clock A.M.

SECOND JUDICIAL DAY.

Codes and Statutes of the State of Oregon, as amended and filed in the office of the Secretary of State, it is hereby ORDERED by the Court that Royal Jones, Supervisor of Road District No. 25, be, and he is hereby directed to sell said wire to the highest

bidder for cash in hand, and to make due return thereof to this Court.

In the Matter of the Proposed County Road petitioned for by F. H. Owsley, et al.,

Now at this time comes the petitioners for the above entitled County road and pay into Court the sum of \$100.00, the same being the amount of damages assessed by the Board of County Road Viewers sustained by E.J.Dunn, caused by reason of said road passing over and across the lands owned by him. And it further appearing to the Court that all the proceedings had have been regular and according to law.

It is therefore CONSIDERED and ORDERED by the Court that the surveyors profile and plat of the proposed county road, and his field notes of the survey thereof, be placed on record in the Book of Plats of County Road of Union County, Oregon, and that said proposed road be declared a public highway of Union County, Oregon, and ordered opened up and placed in repair for travel according to law, and that E.Z.Carbine, Road Supervisor of Road/District No. 20, the same being the Road District in which said road is located, be furnished with a copy of the petition herein, and a copy of this decree and ordered to open up said road and place the same in repair for travel.

Thereupon the Journal of today's proceedings was read, approved and is here now signed, and it was ORDERED that Court be now adjourned for the term.
