

It is hereby ORDERED that said Grande Ronde Electric Company may construct, maintain and operate its telephone lines, and its lines and wires for the purpose of conveying electricity and electric power and energy along, across, and over the public highways in Union County, Oregon, between the points above indicated, upon the most direct, feasable and practical route. The poles carrying said wires for the purposes aforesaid shall be set on the side of the road-way outside of the line of public travel, and so as not to interfere therewith, and not more than two and one-half feet inside of the outer line of the roadway. That such poles carrying said wires shall be set not over one hundred and fifty feet apart, and that such poles shall be set firmly in the ground so as to successfully sustain the wires strung thereon, and resist the ordinary blowing of the wind. That at all corners and angles such poles shall be thoroughly and securely braced so as to prevent same from leaning or falling from the weight of the wire or wind. That where said power wires cross the public highways or private crossing thereon the poles shall be of sufficient height to permit of all power wires strung thereon being at least thirty feet above the level of the roadway or private crossing, and that at other points on said lines the poles shall be of sufficient height to string the power wires thereon at least twenty feet above the surface of the ground.

The said telephone and the said electric power line so constructed, maintained and operated by the said Grande Ronde Electric Company shall be carefully and substantially constructed and maintained and carefully operated and in such manner as to interfere as little as possible with public travel over said public roads and highways and with the private and other road crossings thereon.

The right of way and franchise hereby granted shall take effect and be in force from this date upon its acceptance in writing of the said Grande Ronde Electric Company.
