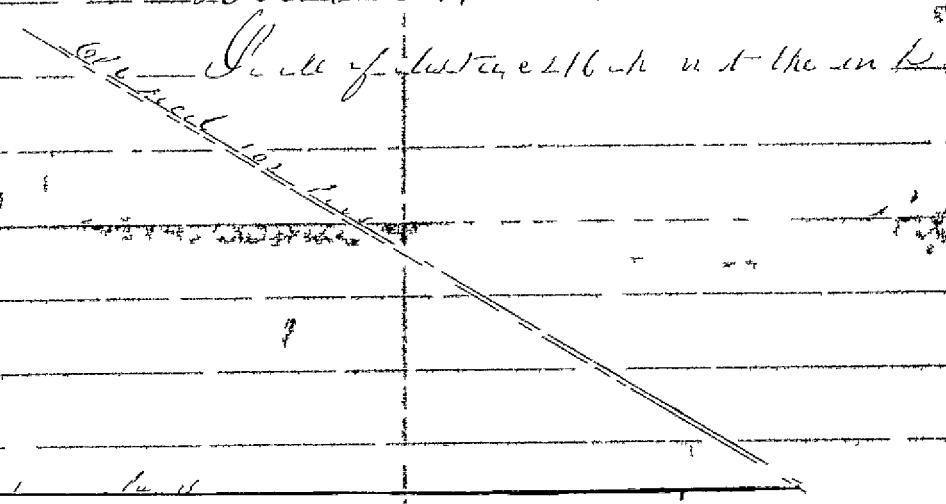

 Court met pursuant to adjournment
 Same Officers present as of yesterday

Due proclamations of the Opening of Court
 having been made the following Business
 was transacted

In the Matter of Change²
 in County Road ³

Now at this time
 was presented a petition praying for a Change
 in that part of the County Road between
 Ore Dell and Union Town, commencing at
 the NW corner of Sec 13 T 3 S R 38 E and
 running on an angle through the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of
 said section, and thence through the NW $\frac{1}{4}$
 of Sec 18 T 3 S R 39 E to be changed as follows
 to wit: commencing at the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ corner
 of Sec 13 T 3 S R 38 E thence running South
 one half mile, thence East one mile and a
 quarter through Sec 13 and 18 until it connects
 with the road as now located,

which petition was signed by more than
 twelve resident householders living in the
 vicinity and along the route of said proposed
 change, which petition was accompanied
 by a Bond duly approved by the court as
 well as by proof of notices having been
 posted according to law more than thirty
 days prior to this time.

It is therefore Ordered that John Bartman
 Peter Moore and William Ewing be and they are
 hereby appointed Viewers, who are to meet at
 the House of A Booleys on the 6th day of June
 1874 and after being duly sworn proceed

to mark and locate said alteration and report their doings at the next term of this Court,

Precinct is hereby declared Vacant.

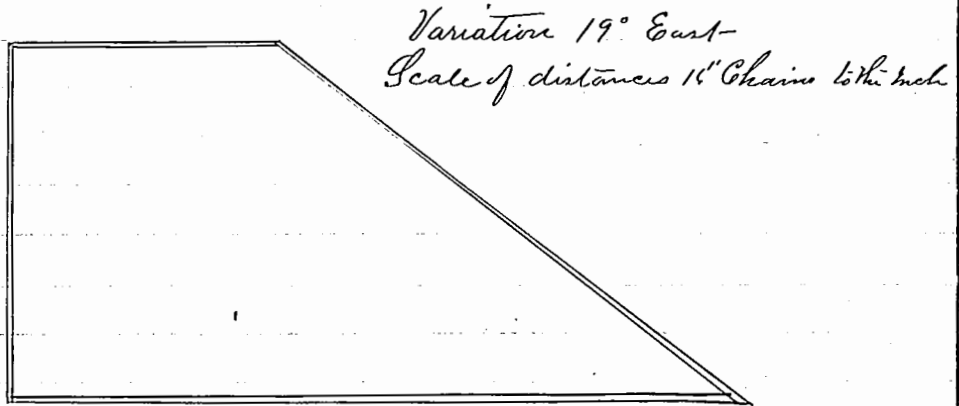

Viewers Report. Now on this ~~day~~ was acted upon: a petition signed by more than twelve resident householders residing in the vicinity and along the route hereinafter proposed road. Praying for an alteration in the county road running from Orrell to Usintown commencing at the N. W. Corner of S. 13. T. 3. S. R. 38 E and running on an angle through the N. 1/2 of said section and also through the N. W. 1/4 of section 18 T. 3. S. R. 39 E. to be changed as follows to wit Commencing at the N. W. Corner of S. 13. T. 3. S. R. 38 E. and running on half mile South, and then East one mile and a quarter through S 13 + 18 until it connects with the road as now located, all of which points are in Union County Oregon, which petition was duly accompanied with a bond which bond was duly approved by the Court also proof that petitioners had been posted according to law.

And upon a second reading of the report of the Reviewers appointed to review said Road the Reviewers having reported favorable. It is ordered that the Prayer of the Petitioners be granted, and that the same be declared a public Highway in accordance with the plot and field notes as hereinafter presented.
