

Comes now S. L. Burnaugh, one of the petitioners for the above named proposed county road, and presents to the Court the petition of himself and others, praying for the location and establishment of a county road, described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the County road as now established about 13½ rods north of the northwest corner of Elgin Cemetry where is located a stake marked "Stake B", thence east across Clark's Creek, thence following the bank of said Creek exposed to the east and north as near as practicable to said Creek a distance of about one mile to a point on the county road as now established where is located a stake marked "Stake A" and being about 57 rods in a northwesterly direction from S. And it appearing to the Court that said petition is signed by more than twelve freeholders of this county, residing in the road district where the hereinbefore described road is proposed to be, and that said petition properly specifies the place of beginning, intermediate points and place of termination of said road, and it satisfactorily appearing to the court that notice has been given by advertisement posted at the place of holding County Court, to-wit: At the Court House in the City of La Grande, County of Union, State of Oregon, and also in three public places in the vicinity of said proposed road, to-wit: one on the county bridge about eleven rods north of the northwest corner of Elgin Cemetry and at the point of commencement of road as described in the petition; one on a post at Barnes & Son old mill site and being near the center of the road proposed as described in the petition therefor, and being on the present county road; and one on a fence at the terminus of the proposed road as described in the petition being at its intersection with the county road as now established, for more than thirty days immediately prior to the presentation of said petition to this court, notifying all persons concerned that application would be made to this Court, at the present session of this court, and that the notices so posted were in due form and duly signed by the petitioners, and that a bond for the cost of this proceeding has been duly given.

It is therefore ORDERED that Arthur Curtis, County Surveyor, and Thos Brasher and

REPORT OF BOARD OF COUNTY ROAD VIEWERS.

TO THE HONORABLE COUNTY COURT OF UNION COUNTY, OREGON:

The undersigned Board of County Road Viewers heretofore on the 4th day of May, 1910, instructed to view, lay out and alter the proposed county road, of which the survey hereto attached is a true and correct description, as petitioned for by S. L. Burnaugh et al., beg leave to report that on the 16 day of May, 1910, in pursuance with said order, we proceeded to view out said proposed road for the whole distance
