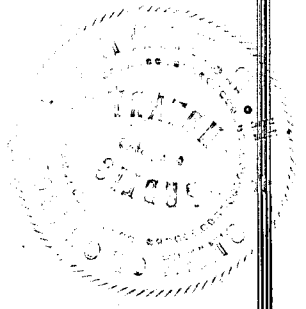

Herewith claim for damages to crops and loss of ground on account of public road being viewed, surveyed and granted across the northwest quarter of Sec. 35, Tp. 5 S. R. 39 E.W.M., the same being the new road leading from the A. C. Spain corner to the main road from Union to North Powder near the H. C. Bidwell place, in the sum of \$25.00.

This road is to be 25 feet wide and runs across me for 1/2 mile and this being now in fall grain, I feel that the claim is very small when you consider that it will take up a little over 1 1/2 acres of land besides the crops. I do not wish to be hard nor arbitrary in public matters and yet believe that I should be reimbursed for a portion of the damages, and know that \$25.00 will be a small return for the loss to me, especially as I will have practically no use of the road.

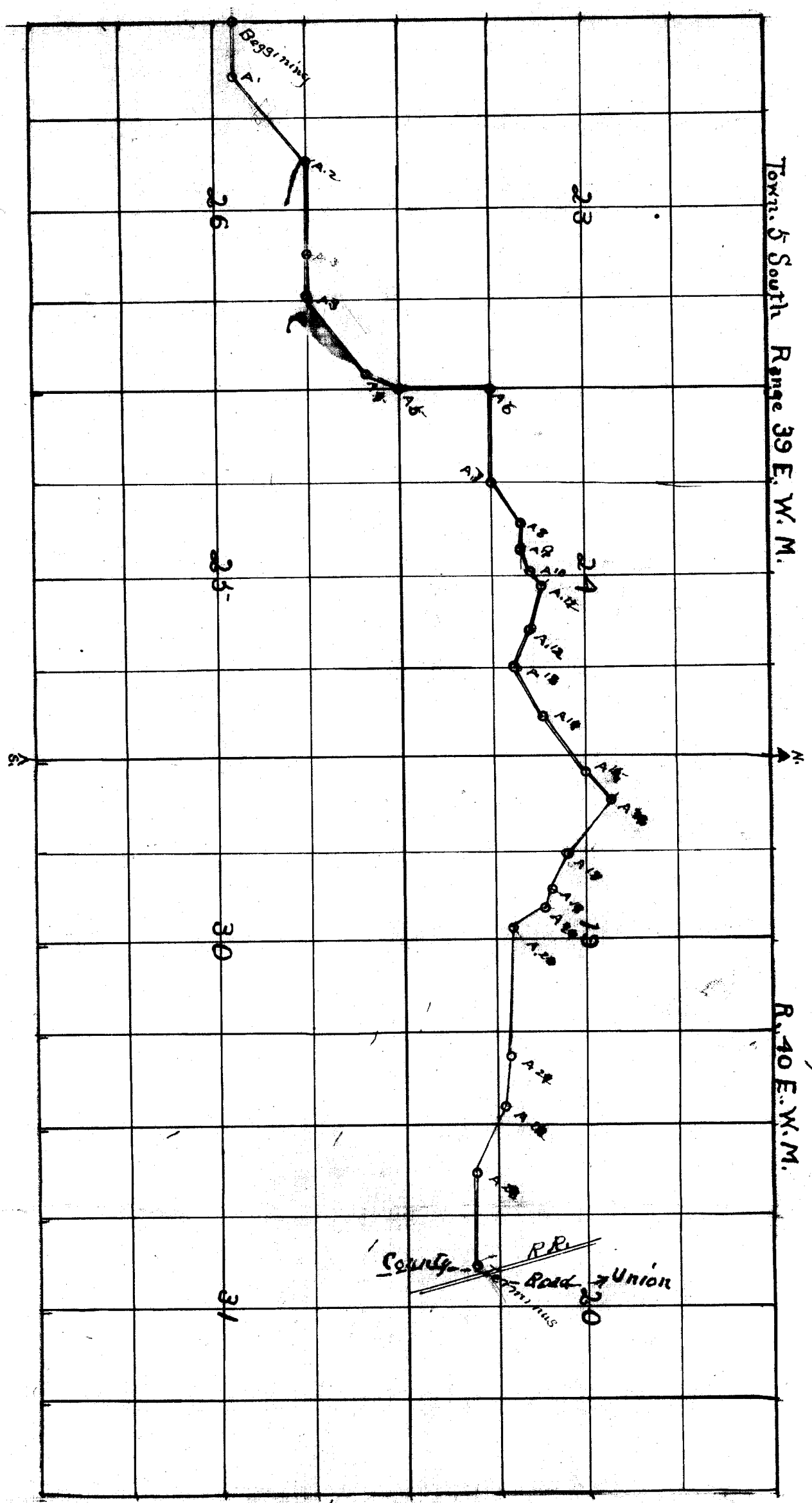

And it appearing to the court that said petition is signed by more than twelve freeholders of this county, residing in the road district where the hereinbefore described road is proposed to be, and that said petition properly specifies the place of beginning, intermediate points and place of termination of said road, and it satisfactorily appearing to the court that notice has been given by advertisement posted at the place of holding County Court, to-wit: At the Court House in the City of La Grande, County of Union, State of Oregon, and also in three public places in the vicinity of said proposed road, to-wit: One on the front gate at the ranch of G.F.Hall on the main road leading to North Powder, a few rods south of the beginning of the road; one on the gate post at the Barger ranch on the road leading from Hog Valley to Telocaset; and one on a telephone post near the terminus of the road and near Wm. Titus residence for more than thirty days immediately prior to the presentation of said petition to this Court, notifying all persons concerned that application would be made to this court, at the present session of this court, and that the notices so posted were in due form and duly signed by the petitioners, and that a bond for the costs of this proceeding has been duly given.

It is therefore ORDERED that Arthur Curtis, County Surveyor, and Thomas Brasher and _____, constituting the Board of County Road Viewers, be, and they are hereby directed to meet at the A.C.Spain place on the 18th day of October, 1910, at the hour of 10 o'clock A.M., or within five days thereafter and proceed to survey, view and lay out said road according to law.

Thereupon the Journal of today's proceedings was read, approved and is here now signed, and it was ORDERED that Court be now adjourned for the term.
