To the Honorable County Court Of Union County.

In the matter of the road petition of Jas, Hoatson, L. W. Ragsdale and others, due to come before the Dec. term of Court; I wish to say with regard to reducing the road from sixty feet wide its present width, to fifty feet wide, that I am familiar with the road along the south and east sides of section 15, Township 3, South, Range 40, E.W.M. in Union County Oregon, and that it has no virtue; that it cannot afford to lose especially any of the right of way.

I have often in the last year and a half seen this road in such a condition of mud, that little girls on their way to school would crawl through several barb wire fences in order to walk in the fields along the road. To reduce this roads right of way, no matter how badly these people want the land, or how many innocent people have signed the petition, would be a very gross error on the part of the court.

Therefore I ask the court to deny their petition as unlawful, and seeking to injure the County Road.
