The undersigned freeholders, of Union county, Oregon, residing in the road district where the hereinafter described road is proposed to be, respectfully petition your Honorable body to lay out, alter and establish a County Road within said county, on the following line, or route, to-wit: Commencing at a point on the County Road at the Southeast corner of the Northeast Quarter (NE 1/4) of the Southwest Quarter (SW 1/4) of Section Twenty (20), in Township Three (3) South, of Range Thirty-seven (37) East of the Willamette Meridian, and running thence North, as near as practicable on the quarter section line through the center of said Section 20 to its intersection with the County Road running north and south at a stake driven in the ground about 150 feet west of the Northeast corner of the Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4) of the Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4) of said Section 20 to a stake driven into the ground, and there terminate. 

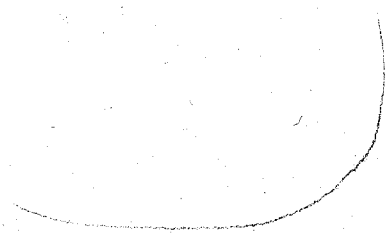
