REPORT OF BOARD OF COUNTY ROAD VIEWERS.

TO THE HONORABLE COUNTY COURT OF UNION COUNTY, OREGON:

The undersigned Board of County Road Viewers heretofore on the 2nd day of Aug. 1911, instructed to view, lay out and alter the proposed county road, of which the survey hereto attached is a true and correct description, as petitioned for by Joseph Wright et al, beg leave to report that on the 23 day of Aug. 1911, in pursuance with said order, we proceeded to view out said proposed road for the whole distance thereof, and that in our opinions said proposed road should be laid out, established as a public highway of Union County, Oregon; that the same is practicable and would add greatly to the convenience of the householders residing in the vicinity thereof. We therefore recommend that said proposed road be laid out and declared a public highway of said county and that the \$350.00 damages asked for by William Buchanan be not allowed, as the road will be more benefit to him than damages.

And said report of the Board of County Road Viewers having been now publicly read in open court on two several days of a previous term of the Court, and it appearing to the court that said Board of County Road Viewers report favorable thereon, and recommend that said proposed road be established as a county road and be declared a public highway of Union County, Oregon, and all the proceedings herein having been regular and according to law, and the claim for damages filed herein being here now disallowed, and there having been no cause shown why this proposed road should not be declared a public highway and ordered open according to law, and the court being satisfied from the report of the Board of County Road Viewers that such road will be of public utility; the report of the viewers being favorable thereto, and all the files and records of said proceedings having been submitted to the District Attorney, who has advised this court as to the legility of said proceedings,

It is therefore CONSIDERED and ORDERED by the Court that the report of the Board of County Road Viewers be placed on record in this journal, and that the surveyor's profile and plat of the proposed road, and his field-notes of the survey thereof be placed on record in the Book of Plats of County Roads of Union County, Oregon, and that said proposed road be declared a public highway of Union County, Oregon, and ordered opened up and placed in repair for travel according to law, and that M.D.Sanderson, Road Supervisor of Road District No. 8, the same being the road district in which said road is located, be furnished with a copy of the petition herein, and a copy of this decree and ordered to open up said road and place the same in repair for travel.
