

It appearing to the court at this time that the report of the Woard of County Road Viewers heretofore directed to view and lay out the road of public easement as petitioned for by A. J. Tucker, is not in due form of law.

It is therefore CONSIDERED and ORDERED that the Clerk of this court notify said county Board of Road Viewers to amend their report to conform to law, and it is further ORDERED that this matter be and the same is hereby continued for the term.

In the matter of the application of the Eastern Oregon Light and Power Company for the right to construct, maintain and operate lines and wires for the purpose of conveying electric power and dectric currect and telephone lines along the public roads and highwaysand county roads of Union County, Oregon.

This matter coming on for hearing on the petition of the Eastern Oregon Light and Powe Company, petitioning this court for the right to construct, maintain and operate telephone lines, and lines and wires for the purpose of conveying electric current along the public roads in Union County, Oregon. And it appearing that the right to construct, operate and maintain said telephone lines should be granted; therefore, it is

CONSIDERED, ORDERED and ADJUDGED that the right to construct, operate and maintain said telephone lines, lines and wires for the purpose of conveying electric current along the public county roads of Union County, Oregon, be, and the same is hereby granted perpetually to the said Eastern Oregon Light and Power Company, in the manner following and with the hereinafter expressed reservations, that is:

That the said Eastern Oregon Light & Power Company, its assigns or successors in interest, assume all liability for any personal injury or damage to property that may arise therefrom; and whenever the county desires to change the line of the road, or roads, over which the said telephone line, or lines, are constructed, operated and maintained, the said Eastern Oregon Light and Power Company, its assigns or successors in interest shall remove the poles upon thirty days (30) notice, and said poles must be placed at the extreme outer side of said road or roads, and where any change is made in said road or roads, the said poles must be placed at the extreme outer edge of said change in said road or roads, and the said lines and the said poles and wires strung thereon must continually be kept in first class condition, and should said poles, or any of them, become unsafe, the said Eastern Oregon Light and Power Company, its assigns or successors in interest, shall replace the said unsafe poles with new ones upon five days notice from the County Court of this county; that said telephone lines and lines and wires for the purpose of conveying electric current shall be constructed along one side only of said county road, and

Provided further: that should it be necessary to string said wires across any road

In the matter of the Monthly Allowance for various indigent persons.

Now at this time it appearing to the court that D.W.Souder, Maggie Slagner, Mrs. John Hilderbrandt, Elizabeth A. Garren, Rose Hornbeck, Clara Serles, Mrs. O.Moffitt, Mrs. F.B. Huntley, Mrs. M.A.Tripp, Ella Harris, J.F.Williams, Millie McLachlion, Alfred Banks, Jas. O. Sage, Mrs. Ole Olson are indigent persons and having heretofore applied to this court for a monthly allowance to assist in their mainte ance and support; and it further appearing to the court that they are residents of Union County; that they have not sufficient means to wholly provide for their needs; that they have no friends or relatives who are able or willing to assist them, and after due consideration, the court believes that they are deserving persons and should have an allowance made them.

It is therefore CONSIDERED and ORDERED by the Court that the County Clerk be, and he is hereby authorized and directed to issue warrants on the Genesl Fund of the County for the amounts set opposite their respective names, to-wit: D.W.Souder, \$15.00; Maggie Slagner, \$10.00; Mrs. John Hildebrandt, \$12.50; Elizabeth A. Garren, \$10.00- Rose Hornbeck, \$20.00; Clara Serles, \$10.00; Mrs. O. Moffitt, \$10.00; Mrs. F.B.Huntley, \$12.50; Mrs. M.A.Tripp, \$10.00; Ella Harris, \$10.00; J.F.Williams, \$12.50; Millie McLachLion \$10.00; Alfred Banks, \$10.00; James O. Sage, \$12.50; Mrs. Ole Olson, \$7.50;

In the matter of the petition of A. J. Tucker for Road of public easement.

Now at this time this matter came on to be heard upon the report of the Board of County Road Viewers for a first reading as provided by law. And the said report having now been read in open court, the same is laid over for a second reading upon another day of this term of court.

In the matter of the Monthly Report of the County Treasurer and credits given him.

Comes now John Frawley, County Treasurer of Union County, Oregon, and presents to the court certain vouchers, warrants and receipts showing that he has paid out of the various funds of the county certain sums of money. And it appearing to the court from an examination of said vouchers and warrants that the sums have been duly paid out of the funds applicable thereto, that the warrants were regularly issued on the order of the court, and that the Treasurer should have credit upon his account for the same.

It is therefore ORDERED that said vouchers, receipts, etc., be filed and the Treasurer be given credit therefor as follows:

been collected by said Clerk.

It is therefore CONSIDERED and ORDERED that said petition be granted and the Clerk of this court is hereby authorized and directed to draw a warrant on the General Fund of the County for \$7.50 in favor of said H. E. Dixon as a refund of fees so erroneously paid.

In the matter of the cancellation of County Warrants issued more than 7 years prior to the 1st day of July, 1912.

Now at this time comes Ed Wright, County Clerk, and presents to the court a certified list of county warrants which were issued more than seven years prior to July 1st, 1912, and which have not been paid, and asks the court for an order designating a newspaper in which said warrants shall be advertised in accordance with the provisions of an Act of the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon, approved Feby 25, 1889. And it appearing that the law requires that said warrants be cancelled and that such an order for advertising said warrants should not be made.

It is therefore CONSIDERED and ORDERED that the Clerk of this court advertise in the La Grande Weekly Observer a list of warrants as certified to this court for four weeks or five successive issues of said paper, notifying all persons that if the same are not presented for payment within sixty days from the 1st day of July, 1912, that said warrant and each of them will be cancelled by this court and that payment thereof will be thereafter refused.

In the matter of noxious weeds.

Now at this time it is ORDERED that the County Clerk notify all Road Supervisors to destroy or cause to be destroyed all noxious weeds existing in the county in the manner provided by law.

In the matter of the petition of A. J. Tucker, for a Road of Public Essement.

Now at this time the petition of A.J.Tucker, on file herein, for a road of public easement, 60 feet wide, under the provisions of Lord's Oregon Laws, Secs. 6307 et seq coming on for decision upon the Report of the Board of County Road Viewers; And the court having duly considered the same and finding said report just in all respects; and being now fully advised in the premises;

It is hereby ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the Report of said Board of County Road Viewers be and the same hereby is approved, and confirmed in all respects; that the said road be, and the same hereby is decreed to be a road of public easement

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and a public county road, and the same hereby is established and ordered opened in accordance with the report of said Viewers upon the payment of the damages in said report set forth, and the costs and expenses of this proceeding, and that said road be recorded as such.

In the matter of the application Nels Holverson for License to sell liquors in less quantities than one gallon in Hilgard, Oregon.

This matter came on to be heard at this time on the petition of Nels Holverson for a license to sell spirituous, vinous and malt liquors in less quantities than one gallon at Hilgard, Oregon, for a period of six months from the 7th day of June, A. D. 1912, and it appearing to the court that said petition is signed by a majority of the legal voters of Hilgard precinct and that legal notice thereof has been given as is evidenced by the affidavit of publication filed herein; that said notice was published in the La Grande Weekly Observer, a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in La Grande, Union County, Oregon, for the period of five consecutive weeks; that proof of notice being posted during the period of publication in compliance with the requirements of the law governing petitions for such licenses has been filed herein; that the applicant has paid to the Treasurer of Union County, Oregon, the sum of \$200.00, and filed the Treasurer's receipt for same with the Clerk of this Court; that he has filed a good and sufficient bond in the sum of \$1000.00; that no remonstrance or petition against the issuance of said license has been filed herein, and it further appearing to the court that said license should be granted

It is therefore CONSIDERED, ORDERED and ADJUDGED that allicense issue to Nels Holverson to sell spirituous, vinous and malt liquors in less quantities than one gallon at Hilgard in Hilgard Precinct, Union County, Oregon, for a period of six months from the 7th day of June, A. D. 1912.

Thereupon the Journal of today's proceedings was read, approved and is here now signed, and it was ORDERED that Court be now adjourned for the term.
