

REPORT OF BOARD OF COUNTY ROAD VIEWERS.

TO THE HONORABLE COUNTY COURT OF UNION COUNTY, OREGON:

The undersigned Board of County Road Viewers heretofore on the Thursday 9th day of January, 1913, instructed to view, lay out and alter the proposed county road, of which the survey hereto attached is a true and correct description as petitioned for by W.R. Jasper, et al., beg leave to report that on the 21st day of January, 1913, in pursuance with said order, we proceeded to view out said proposed road for the whole distance thereof, and trat in our opinions said proposed road should be laid out and established as a public highway of Union County, Oregon; that the same is practicable and would add much to the convenience of the householders residing in the vicinity thereof. We therefore recommend that said proposed road be laid out and declared a public highway of said county and that there are damage bills filed with the Board (one written by Thos. Wallsinger and one verbal by Geo. E. Wells) Wallsinger's bill is attached herewith) We estimate the damage at \$100.00 per acre for each party.

Wells are deprived of the use of 1.21 acres of land and that their damages as fixed by the Board of County Road Viewers amount to the sum of \$121.00 each, and there having been no cause shown why this proposed road should not be declared a public highway and ordered open according to law, and the court being satisfied from the report of the Board of County Road Viewers that such road will be of public utility; the report of the viewers being favorable thereto, and all the files and records of said proceedings having been submitted to the District Attorney, who has advised this court as to the legality of said proceedings,

It is therefore CONSIDERED and ORDERED by the court that the report of the Board of County Road Viewers be placed on record in this journal, and that the surveyor's profit and plat of the proposef road, and his fixed-notes of the survey thereof be placed on record in the Book of Plats of County roads of Union County, Oregon, and that said proposed road be declared a public highway of Union County, Oregon, and ordered opened up and placed in repair for travel according to law, upon the payment by the petitioners to Thos. Wallsinger and Geo. E. Wells damages in the sum of \$121.00 each, and that J.F. Campbell, Road Supervisor of Road District No. 3, the same being the road district in which said road is located, be furnished with a copy of the petition herein, and a copy of this decree and ordered to open up said road and place the same in repaid for travel.

Now at this time this matter came on for hearing upon the application of I.U. Temple for the vacation of said above described road, and it appearing to the Chrt that on Thursday, the 6th day of Feburary, 1913, after due and regular proceeding in the above road matter, a road as petitions for in the petition therein was declared to be a public highway and orderedopened for public travel upon the payment by the petitioners of the amount of damages assessed in said road matter, and that said petitioners have failed, neglected and refused to pay the amount of damages so assessed, and that threeyears have elapsed sime auch order was made by this Court, and that no effort has been made on the part of petitioners to comply with said order and that said order should be revoked and rescinded. It is therefore CONSIDERED and ORDERED that said order in said above road matter duly made and enetered on Thursday the 6th day of February, 1913, be and the same is hereby revoked, set aside and held for neight, and that said road so pretended to be declared a public highway by such order be and the same is hereby vacated, and that all proceedings heretofore held and had in said road matter be and the same are hereby set aside and held for neight.
