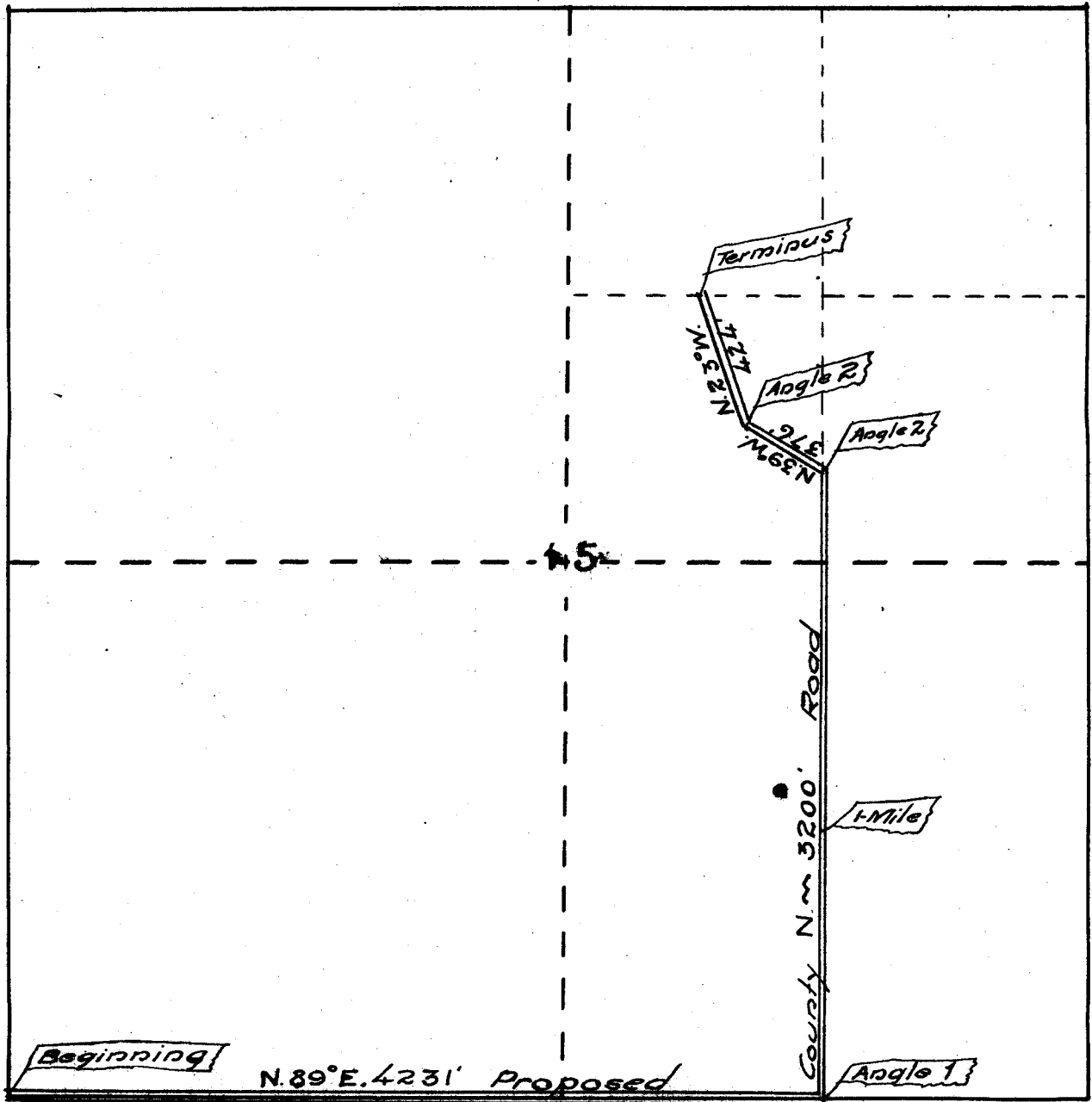

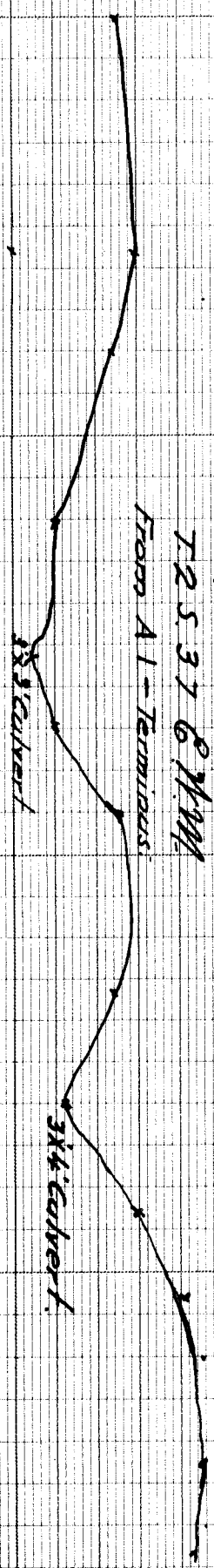

Campbell, Road Supervisor of Road District No. 3, the same being the road district in which said road is located, be furnished with a copy of the petition herein, and a copy of this decree and ordered to open up said road and place the same in repair for travel, upon payment into court by the petitioners of one half of the expense of opening the road.
