And said report having been publicly read and there having been no objections thereto, nor objections to the establishment of said road or claim for damages filed, and the court being satisfied that such road will be of utility and convenient to individuals and to the public.

It is therefore CONSIDERED and ORDERED that the County Surveyor record said road upon the Plat Book and records of the County, said road being here now declared to be a public highway of the county without further survey, and J. L. Woodell, Road Supervisor of Road District No. 7 is hereby authorized and directed to open said road and place the same in repair for travel.

In the Matter of the Application of A. J. Tucker for cancellation of tax lien.

Now at this time this matter came on for hearing upon the application of A. J. Tucker for the cancellation of a tax lien on the following described land:— North $\frac{1}{2}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 8, and N $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 9 Tp. 2 N. R. 39 E.W.M. from which application it appears that the taxes for the year 1898 assessed against the above described real property became delinquent and that said premises were sold to Union County pursuant to the laws then in force for the collection of delinquent taxes; and it further appearing that the said applicant has tendered into court the sum of \$15.95, the amount for which said property was so sold to Union County.

It is therefore CONSIDERED and ORDERED that said application for cancellation be granted and the County Clerk is hereby directed to pay to the Sheriff of Union County the sum of \$15.95 as tendered to him by the said applicant and the said Sheriff is hereby authorized and directed to cancel said lien upon the record and to turn said money over to the County Treasurer in the manner provided by law.

Thereupon the Journal of to-day's proceedings was read, approved and is here now signed and it was ORDERED that Court be now adjourned for the term.
