PETITION FOR CHANGE OF COUNTY ROAD

To the Honorable County Court for Union County, State of Oregon;-

The undersigned freeholders of Union County, Oregon, residing in the Road District, vicinity, Neighborhood and part of said County where the hereinafter described road is proposed to be; said undersigned freeholders being those effected by said proposed change, respectfully petition your Honorable Body to lay out, alter and establish a County Road within said County on the hereinafter described line or route, for the reason that in the improvement of said county road it will be advantageous to change the grade and location of such county road hereinafter described (not departing from the general route of such established or traveled county road) so as to avoid dangerous and difficult curves, steep and heavy and dangerous grades and to avoid unsafe, unsubstantial and expensive foundations and for other reasonable causes; The old road proposed to be changed is described as follows; Commencing on the County road leading from Union to Medical Springs at the bridge below the old Robbins mill, thence Easterly up the hill past the Morgan place and through the Godsey place running south of Catherine Creek to where same crosses Catherine Creek over bridge; The proposed change or route would be as follows , to wit; Commencing on the County road on Catherine Creek leading from Union to Medical Springs at the bridge below the old Robbins mill, thence up the north side of Catherine Creek ~~thru~~ the Clarence Morgan place through the Godsey place and intersecting the old county road at or near the bridge across Catherine Creek above the Godsey place
