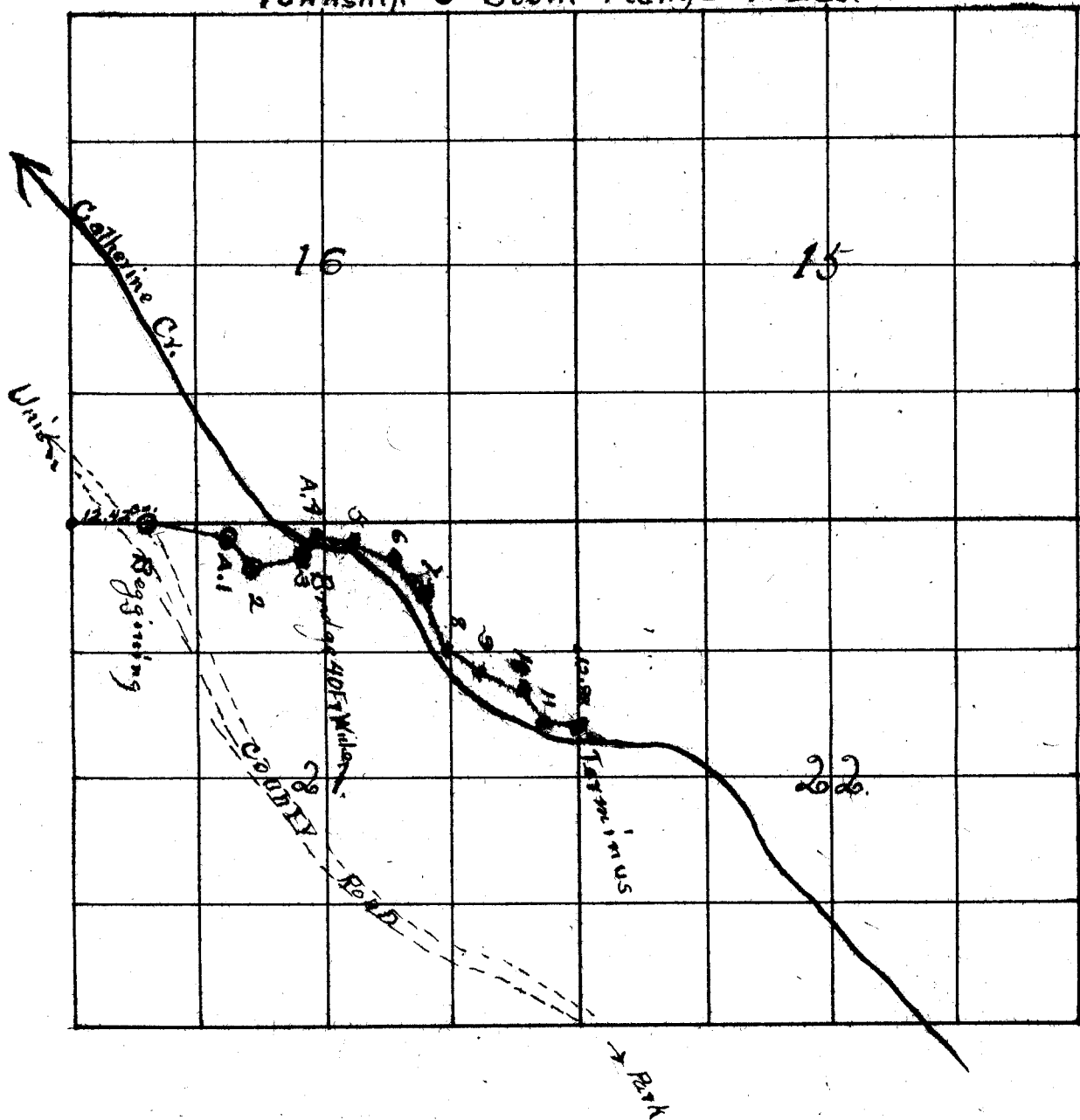

To your Hon. Body:

I, Arthur Curtis, who was appointed to investigate the proposed county road as petitioned for by J. B. Thompson and others, beg leave to report as follows:-

That I went over said road for the whole distance thereof and find that the grade is good or only water grade, and that said road will only require one bridge across Catherine Creek and that there is a bridge across said creek but not in the proper place to do the least damage to the property owners according to the amount of benefit to be derived from same.

I therefore recomend that the petition of the petitioners be granted and that an actual survey of said road, and that said road be built along said line of survey, and that they do not follow said road for the entire distance as now traveled and been traveled for ten (10) years or more.
