New proposed road to Medical Springs.

The two changes in the present road to Medical Springs from Union consist of approximately 1 3/4 miles of new grade at the summit and about 2 1/2 miles of new grade near what is known as the old water mill.

The present grade at the summit is very steep, being 15% to 16% in places. It is proposed to eliminate this grade by following a lower and more gradual line around the hill which will make it rossible to secure a 4% grade on the Medical Springs side of the summit and a 6% grade on the Union side of the summit. The full 1 3/4 miles at this point in in very thich brush while the timber of any great size is scattered and thin. On the Medical Springs side of the summit the new proposed grade will run along the south slope which efcourse will give it a better eppertunity to ary ent after storms, etc. On the Union side of the summit it would be impossible to change to read from the north slope without a great cost and the changing of a number of miles of The read supervisor reports that the cost for the grade. construction of road of this nature will be approximately \$300.00 per. mile. Parties at Medical Springs have been given copy of description and location of read as surveyed by this department and are new circulating petition.

I, the undersigned, County Surveyor, appointed to survey the County Road proposed by A. J. VandeVanter, et al., beg leave to report that on the 26th day of June, 1916, in pursuance of said appointment and order, I surveyed said proposed road for the mail distance the following being the field notes. the whole distance thereof, the following being the field notes of said survey: -

Beginning at a rock marked "R", in the County road, 272 feet East of the N.W.Corner of the S.W. 4 of the N.W. 4, Sec. 27, T. 5 S., R.41 E., running thence as per the attached field notes and terminating at a rock marked "R", in the County road, 1610.5 feet West and 1847.7 feet North of the S.E. corner of Sec. 34, T.5 S., R.41 E.




